leading within them and cumulative widening student achievement gaps In combination there are almost no examples of low performing secondary schools turning around The chapters in this book begin to offer some hope about how policymakers practitioners and researchers might begin to reconceptualize how they engage in and undertake the work of rapidly improving low performing secondary schools The authors provide theoretical and conceptual advancements offer lessons learned from both successful and unsuccessful initiatives and address practical issues with potentially accessible ways forward
