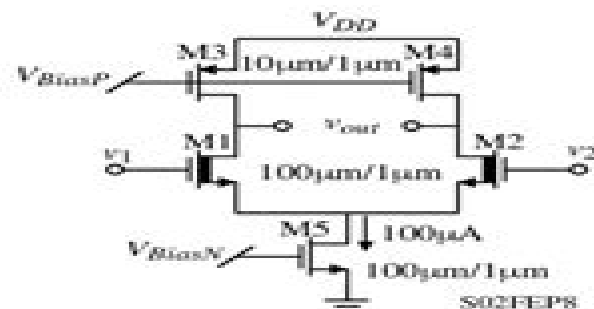


Homework Assignment No. 13Due Friday, April 18, 2003 in classProblem 1 - (10 points)

Assume that the normal MOSFETs parameters are $K_N' = 110\text{V}/\mu\text{A}^2$, $V_{TN} = 0.7\text{V}$, $\lambda_N = 0.04\text{V}^{-1}$ and for the PMOS transistors are $K_P' = 50\text{V}/\mu\text{A}^2$, $V_{TP} = -0.7\text{V}$, $\lambda_P = 0.05\text{V}^{-1}$. For the depletion mode NMOS transistors, the parameters are the same as the normal NMOS except that $V_{TN} = -0.5\text{V}$. (a.) What is the maximum input common-mode voltage, $V_{icm}^*(\text{max})$? (b.) What is the minimum input common-mode voltage, $V_{icm}^*(\text{min})$? (c.) What value of V_{DD} gives an $ICMR = 0.5V_{DD}$?

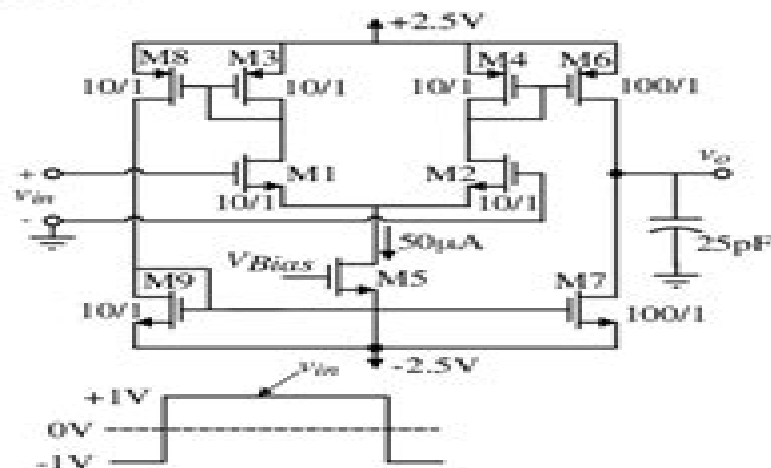
