

Polynomial Factoring

WARNING--THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!!!!**Sum and Difference of Two Cubes**

There are special factoring case patterns when given binomials you will need to be familiar with.

Difference of two squares: $a^2 - b^2 = (a + b)(a - b)$

Example: $4x^2 - 81y^2 = (2x + 9y)(2x - 9y)$

Difference of two cubes: $a^3 - b^3 = (a - b)(a^2 + ab + b^2)$

Example: $x^3 - 27 = (x - 3)(x^2 + 3x + 9)$

Sum of two cubes: $a^3 + b^3 = (a + b)(a^2 - ab + b^2)$

Example: $8x^3 + 1 = (2x + 1)(4x^2 - 2x + 1)$

Recalling the signs in the pattern can be difficult. If you can remember **SLOP**, you will be fine!

Here's another approach:

$27x^3 + 8 = ($	$)$	Make two parenthesis.
$= ($	$)$	
$= (3x + 2)($	$)$	What times what times what = $27x^3$? What times what times what = $+ 8$? Put these in the first parenthesis.
$= (3x + 2)(9x^2$	$+ 4)$	$3x$ times what = $27x^3$? Write this in 2 nd parenthesis. 2 times what = 8 ? Write this in second parenthesis.
$= (3x + 2)(9x^2$	$-6x + 4)$	Multiply the terms in the first parenthesis and take the opposite sign.
