There are special factoring case patterns when given binomials you will need to be familiar with.

Difference of two squares:  $a^2 - b^2 = (a + b)(a - b)$ 

**Example:**  $4x^2 - 81y^2 = (2x + 9y)(2x - 9y)$ 

Difference of two cubes:  $a^3 - b^3 = (a - b)(a^2 + ab + b^2)$ 

**Example:**  $x^3-27 = (x-3)(x^2+3x+9)$ 

Sum of two cubes:  $a^3 + b^3 = (a + b)(a^2 - ab + b^2)$
