 60 g to 100 g 120 cm² to 160

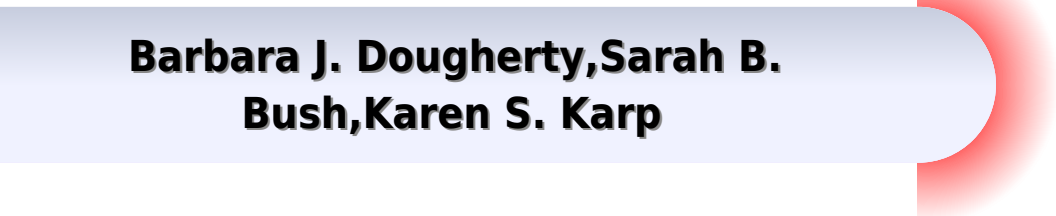
- (b) Estimate a formula to represent the relationship between the surface area of the shell of an egg and the mass of the egg.
