Study of the human organism and its internal body



Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its internal organs.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its internal organs.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the human body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of the cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of the tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of the organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of the systems.
- 6. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole organism.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.
- 2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.
- 3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between the cells.
- 4. **Transcellular fluid** - fluid within the body cavities.



The neuron is the basic unit of the nervous system. It is a specialized cell that transmits information throughout the body.

Neuron types

Neurons are classified into three types:

- 1. **Sensory neurons** - receive information from the environment.
- 2. **Motor neurons** - transmit information to the muscles.
- 3. **Interneurons** - connect sensory and motor neurons.

ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues that perform a specific function.

Examples of organs include the heart, lungs, stomach, and liver.

Organs are made up of different types of tissues, including:

- 1. **Epithelial tissue** - covers the body and organs.
- 2. **Connective tissue** - supports and connects the body.
- 3. **Muscle tissue** - contracts to move the body.
- 4. **Nervous tissue** - transmits information.

Organ systems

Organ systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

Examples of organ systems include the digestive system and the circulatory system.

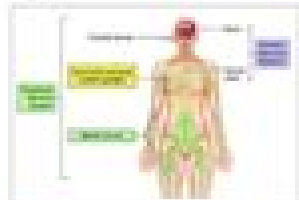
Neurons

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

They are responsible for transmitting information throughout the body.

Neurons are made up of different parts, including:

- 1. **Cell body** - contains the nucleus and other organelles.
- 2. **Dendrites** - receive information from other neurons.
- 3. **Axon** - transmits information to other neurons.
- 4. **Myelin sheath** - covers the axon and insulates it.



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NERVOUS SYSTEM

The nervous system is responsible for controlling and coordinating the body's activities.

It is made up of the brain, spinal cord, and peripheral nerves.

The nervous system is divided into two main parts:

- 1. **Central nervous system** - consists of the brain and spinal cord.
- 2. **Peripheral nervous system** - consists of the nerves that connect the central nervous system to the rest of the body.



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ORGAN SYSTEMS OF THE BODY

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ORGAN SYSTEMS

- 1. **Digestive system** - responsible for breaking down food into nutrients.
- 2. **Circulatory system** - transports blood throughout the body.
- 3. **Respiratory system** - takes in oxygen and removes carbon dioxide.
- 4. **Excretory system** - removes waste from the body.
- 5. **Reproductive system** - produces offspring.
- 6. **Immune system** - defends the body against disease.
- 7. **Endocrine system** - produces hormones.
- 8. **Nervous system** - controls the body's activities.
- 9. **Musculoskeletal system** - supports and moves the body.
- 10. **Integumentary system** - covers the body and protects it.

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
