Ex: Find the direction of the line of intersection of the two planes
 $x+3y-z=5$ and $2x-y+4z=3$.

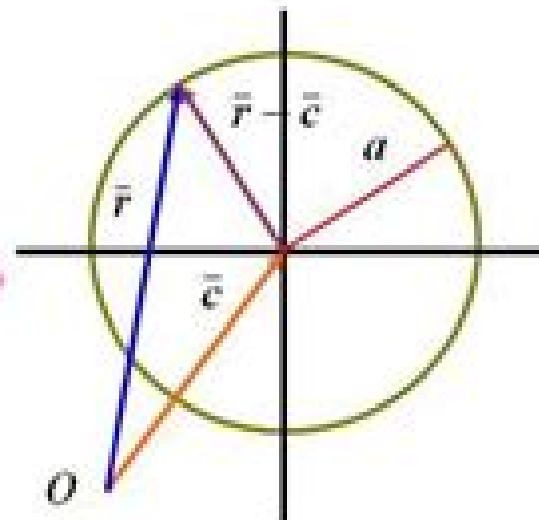
Normal vector of the planes are $\vec{n}_1 = \hat{i} + 3\hat{j} - \hat{k}$ $\vec{n}_2 = 2\hat{i} - \hat{j} + 4\hat{k}$

The direction vector of line is along the direction of

$$\vec{n}_1 \times \vec{n}_2 = \begin{vmatrix} \hat{i} & \hat{j} & \hat{k} \\ 1 & 3 & -1 \\ 2 & -1 & 4 \end{vmatrix} = 10\hat{i} - 6\hat{j} - 8\hat{k}$$

Equation of a sphere with radius a:

$$|\vec{r} - \vec{c}|^2 = (\vec{r} - \vec{c}) \cdot (\vec{r} - \vec{c}) = a^2$$

If you like this book write a review **Clifford (Geometric) Algebras** William Baylis, 1999-04-23 This volume is an outgrowth of the 1995 Summer School on Theoretical Physics of the Canadian Association of Physicists CAP held in Banff Alberta in the Canadian Rockies from July 30 to August 12 1995 The chapters based on lectures given at the School are designed to be tutorial in nature and many include exercises to assist the learning process Most lecturers gave three or four fifty minute lectures aimed at relative novices in the field More emphasis is therefore placed on pedagogy and establishing comprehension than on erudition and superior scholarship Of course new and exciting results are presented in applications of Clifford algebras but in a coherent and user friendly way to the nonspecialist The subject area of the volume is Clifford algebra and its applications Through the geometric language of the Clifford algebra approach many concepts in physics are clarified united and extended in new and sometimes surprising directions In particular the approach eliminates the formal gaps that traditionally separate classical quantum and relativistic physics It thereby makes the study of physics more efficient and the research more penetrating and it suggests resolutions to a major physics problem of the twentieth century namely how to unite quantum theory and gravity The term geometric algebra was used by Clifford himself and David Hestenes has suggested its use in order to emphasize its wide applicability and because the developments by Clifford were themselves based heavily on previous work by Grassmann Hamilton Rodrigues Gauss and others [The Shape of Algebra in the Mirrors of Mathematics](#) Gabriel Katz, Vladimir Nodelman, 2012 The Shape of Algebra is the authors attempt to share their mathematical experiences with readers who have more than a passing interest in mathematics but have only a traditional exposure to elementary algebra Secondary school and college teachers and students who want to expand their horizons in the field will find a fresh presentation of familiar concepts and some unexpected results This book serves as a text for an appreciation course in modern mathematics designed for non mathematics majors or for first year students who are considering the possibility of studying mathematics or related disciplines It can also serve as a source of computer supported activities that could supplement traditional courses in algebra multivariable calculus and complex variable This book gives the reader a sense of the visual nature of mathematics Mathematical experiments with universal mapping software VisuMatica designed by Vladimir Nodelman form the very core of the book Readers are encouraged to reproduce play with and expand on these experiments Numerous problems are interspersed throughout the text to guide the reader Our treatment of standard algebra is visual and computational By introducing visual computational environments like VisuMatica
