#### Physiology

The scientific study of the function of the human body

#### Structural levels

Also known as the levels of organization of the human body

- 1. Chemical level - study of the chemical composition of the body
- 2. Cellular level - study of the structure and function of cells
- 3. Tissue level - study of the structure and function of tissues
- 4. Organ level - study of the structure and function of organs
- 5. System level - study of the structure and function of body systems
- 6. Organism level - study of the structure and function of the whole body

### CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body



#### Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids

Extracellular fluid - fluid outside the cell

Intracellular fluid - fluid inside the cell

Interstitial fluid - fluid between cells

Blood plasma - fluid part of blood

Organic fluids - fluids that contain organic molecules

Inorganic fluids - fluids that do not contain organic molecules

Electrolytes - substances that can conduct electricity

Non-electrolytes - substances that cannot conduct electricity

Acids - substances that release hydrogen ions

Bases - substances that accept hydrogen ions

pH - measure of acidity or alkalinity

Homeostasis - the body's ability to maintain a stable internal environment

Feedback loops - mechanisms that regulate homeostasis

Positive feedback - amplifies a response

Negative feedback - reduces a response

Set point - the desired level of a variable

Range - the acceptable range of a variable

Stimulus - a change in the environment that triggers a response

Receptor - a structure that detects a stimulus

Control center - a structure that processes information and issues commands

Effector - a structure that carries out a response

Response - the body's reaction to a stimulus

Homeostatic imbalance - a failure of the body to maintain homeostasis

Disease - a condition that disrupts normal function

Disorder - a condition that causes abnormal function

Symptom - a subjective experience of a condition

Sign - an objective indication of a condition

Diagnosis - the identification of a condition

Prognosis - the prediction of the outcome of a condition

Treatment - a plan of action to improve a condition

Prevention - measures to avoid a condition

Health - a state of well-being

Wellness - a state of optimal health

Quality of life - a measure of a person's well-being

Longevity - the length of a person's life

Mortality - the rate of death

Morbidity - the rate of disease

Prevalence - the number of cases of a condition at a given time

Incidence - the number of new cases of a condition at a given time

Prevalence rate - the ratio of prevalence to population

Incidence rate - the ratio of incidence to population

Mortality rate - the ratio of mortality to population

Life expectancy - the average number of years a person is expected to live

Health expectancy - the average number of years a person is expected to live in good health

Quality-adjusted life expectancy - the average number of years a person is expected to live, weighted by quality of life

Health-related quality of life - a measure of a person's health status

Functional status - a measure of a person's ability to perform daily activities

Disability - a condition that limits a person's ability to perform daily activities

Handicap - a condition that prevents a person from doing what they would like to do

Impairment - a condition that affects a person's ability to perform a specific task
