Thinking about Society: Theory and Practice Ian Jarvie, 2012-12-06 I C Jarvie was trained as a social anthropologist in the center of British social anthropology the London School of Economics where Bronislaw Malinowski was the object of ancestor worship Jarvie's doctorate was in philosophy however under the guidance of Karl Popper and John Watkins He changed his department not as a defector but as a rebel attempting to exorcize the ancestral spirit He criticized the method of participant observation not as useless but as not comprehensive it is neither necessary nor sufficient for the making of certain contributions to anthropology rather it all depends on the problem situation And so Jarvie remained an anthropologist at heart who in addition to some studies in rather conventional anthropological or sociological molds also studied the tribe of social scientists but also critically examining their problems especially their overall rather philosophical problems but not always so a few of the studies included in this volume exemplify his work on specific issues whether of technology or architecture or nationalism in the academy or moviemaking or even movies exhibiting excessive sex and violence These studies attract his attention both on account of their own merit and on account of their need for new and powerful research tools such as those which he has forged in his own intellectual workshop over the last two decades

The Legacy of Kenneth Burke Herbert W. Simons, Trevor Melia, 1989 Capturing the lively modernist milieu of Kenneth Burke's early career in Greenwich Village where Burke arrived in 1915 fresh from high school in Pittsburgh this book discovers him as an intellectual apprentice conversing with the moderns Burke found himself in the midst of an avant garde peopled by Malcolm Cowley Marianne Moore Jean Toomer Katherine Anne Porter William Carlos Williams Allen Tate Hart Crane Alfred Stieglitz and a host of other fascinating figures Burke himself who died in 1993 at the age of 96 has been hailed as America's most brilliant and suggestive critic and the most significant theorist of rhetoric since Cicero Many schools of thought have claimed him as their own but Burke has defied classification and indeed has often been considered a solitary eccentric genius immune to intellectual fashions But Burke's formative work of the 1920s when he first defined himself and his work in the context of the modernist conversation has gone relatively unexamined Here we see Burke living and working with the crowd of poets painters and dramatists affiliated with Others magazine Stieglitz's 291 gallery and Eugene O'Neill's Provincetown Players the leftists associated with the magazines The Masses and Seven Arts the Dadaists and the modernist writers working on literary journals like The Dial where Burke in his capacity as an associate editor saw T S Eliot's The Wasteland into print for the first time and provided other editorial services for Thomas Mann e e cummings Ezra Pound and many other writers of note Burke also met the iconoclasts of the older generation represented by

Theodore Dreiser and H L Mencken the New Humanists and the literary nationalists who founded Contact and The New Republic Jack Selzer shows how Burke s own early poems fiction and essays emerged from and contributed to the modernist conversation in Greenwich Village He draws on a wonderfully rich array of letters between Burke and his modernist friends and on the memoirs of his associates to create a vibrant portrait of the young Burke s transformation from aesthete to social critic

Laws And Explanation In The Social Sciences Lee C McIntyre,2018-10-08 The first full length defense of social scientific laws to appear in the last twenty years this book upholds the prospect of the nomological explanation of human behavior against those who maintain that this approach is impossible impractical or irrelevant By pursuing an analogy with the natural sciences McIntyre shows that the barriers to nomological inquiry within the social sciences are not generated by factors unique to social inquiry but arise from a largely common set of problems that face any scientific endeavor All of the most widely supported arguments against social scientific laws have failed largely due to adherence to a highly idealized conception of nomologicality allegedly drawn from the natural sciences themselves and the limited doctrine of descriptivism Basing his arguments upon a more realistic view of scientific theorizing that emphasizes the pivotal role of redescription in aiding the search for scientific laws McIntyre is optimistic about attaining useful law like explanations of human behavior
