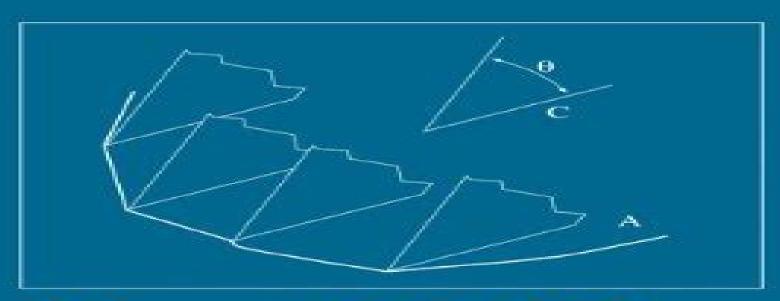

Functional time series are aimed at modelling spatio temporal phenomena for instance rain temperature pollution on a given geographical area with temporally dependent observations Heavy tails mean that the series can exhibit much higher spikes than with Gaussian distributions for instance In such cases second moments cannot be assumed to exist violating the basic assumption in standard functional data analysis based on the sequence of autocovariance operators As for random variables regular variation provides the mathematical backbone for a coherent theory of extreme values The main tools introduced in this thesis for a regularly varying functional time series are its tail process and its spectral process These objects capture all the aspects of the probability distribution of extreme values jointly over time and space The development of the tail and spectral process for heavy tailed functional time series is followed by three theoretical applications.
