The study included a questionnaire which is composed of two previously developed questionnaires the Reflection Questionnaire RQ Kember 2000 and the Revised Study Process Questionnaire R SPQ 2F Biggs et al 2001 for exploring the relationships between students perceptions of blogging and their learning approaches and their level of reflective thinking The results would then triangulate with the findings of content analysis of blog posts and student interviews. The study showed that deep approach scores and scores of reflective thinking scales have been found as a significant contribution to the explanation of the portfolio and total course marks It also showed that there is strong relationship between the learning approach and the students habit of reflective thinking By comparing the pre teaching with post teaching scores it is found that a positive change in the total scores of deep approach in particular in deep strategy subscale and a positive change in the total scores of higher levels of reflective thinking reflection and critical reflection Furthermore the results showed that a negative change in the total scores of the lowest level of reflective thinking habitual action.
