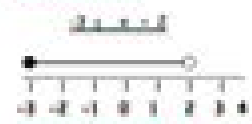
Rules of Indices

 2^{-1} = the reciprocal of 2 (i.e. $\frac{1}{2}$)

Equations
 - Multiply out brackets first
 - If there are letters on both sides get rid of the smaller first
 - Do the same to both sides

e.g.
 To solve $5(x-3) = 3x+7$ (expand brackets)
 $5x-15 = 3x+7$ (x from both sides)
 $2x-15 = 7$ (add 15 to both sides)
 $2x = 22$ (÷ 2 both sides)
 $x = 11$

Expanding brackets

Multiply everything inside the bracket by what is outside. Then collect like terms together.

$3(x+2) = 3x+6$
 $2(x-5) = 2x-10$
 $5(x-2) = 5x-10$

Watch for the negative sign in front of the bracket. It changes the sign inside the bracket.

$3(x+2) - 2(x-5)$
 $= 3x+6-2x+10$
 $= x+16$

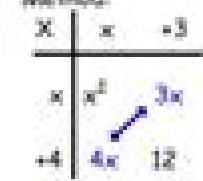
Factorise

If the 1st difference is constant, it is linear

The term to term rule is +4
