American Opportunity: For Whites Only

In 1936, a Black poet wrote of a “young man, full of strength and hope, tangled in an ancient endless chain of profit, power, and gain” (Hughes 25-27). This “young man,” that Langston Hughes eluded to at the height of American class conflict was not a young man from the impoverished countries of Africa or the war-torn lands of Europe. Instead, he was an American. The young American he wrote about is the epitome of *most* Americans, ones with hopes and dreams of succeeding in a country that promised opportunity to the rich born in upscale New York neighborhoods, but also the poor Blacks growing up in cramped inner-city slums. Opportunity in America, however, is not so straightforward. For Hughes’s “American,” they were, and still are, representative of a class of Americans stuck at the bottom of society by a steadfast goal to steal opportunity from people looked at as an obstacle to the capitalist dream. Opportunity for most Americans, contrary to the “rags to riches” selling point of the American dream, is not an uninterrupted path toward economic mobility. Often, the path of opportunity is a path for the rich only, nonexistent for the Americans who can not buy into opportunity. Americans have been unknowingly born into a caste system favoring the rich and the white, built

essay booklet is read and scored by four graders. Each grader provides a score for the individual essays. This score is a number on a scale from 0 to 9, 0 being the lowest and 9 the highest. The graders are not aware of each other's scores. When the essays have been graded four times, the scores are averaged, one score for each of the three essays, so that the free response section is composed of three scores. The three essays are weighted equally and the total weight of the free response section is fifty-five percent of the total score. The multiple choice section accounts for forty-five percent of the total score. Each year the overall grades may fluctuate because the grading scale depends upon the performance of students in past AP administrations. The following method of scoring along with the corresponding chart will give you an approximation of your score. It will not indicate the exact score you would get on the actual AP English Language Composition Exam.
