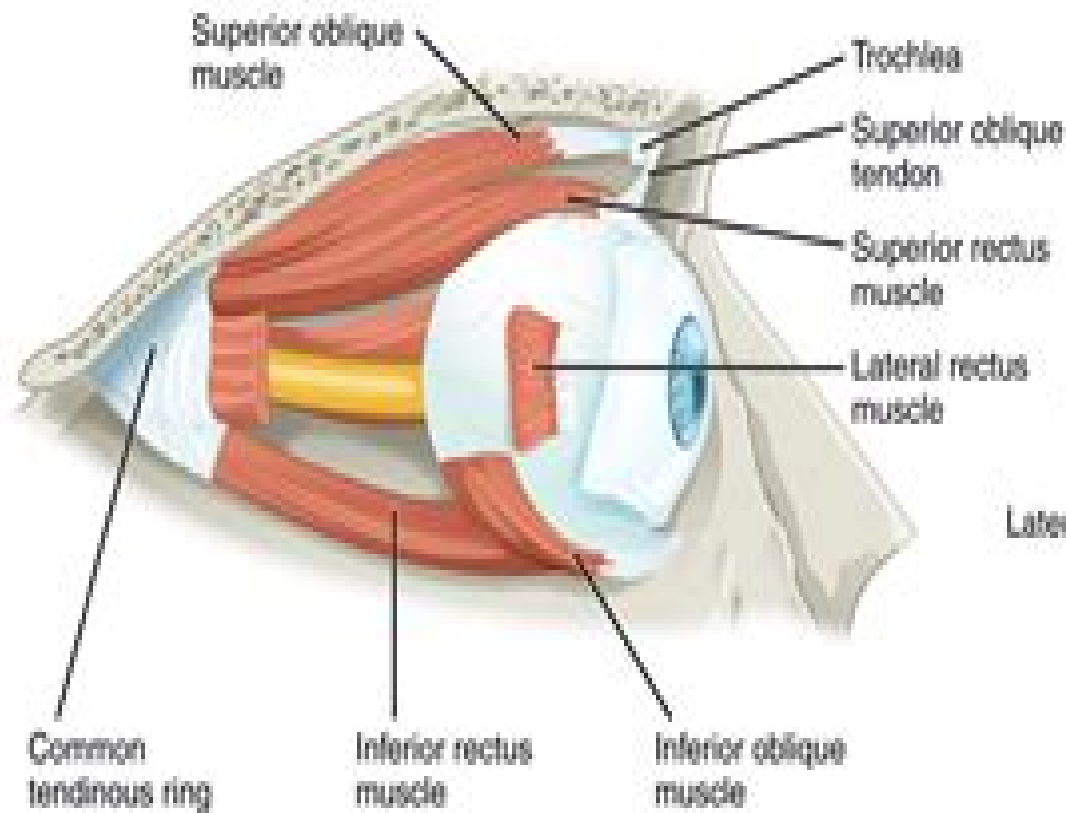
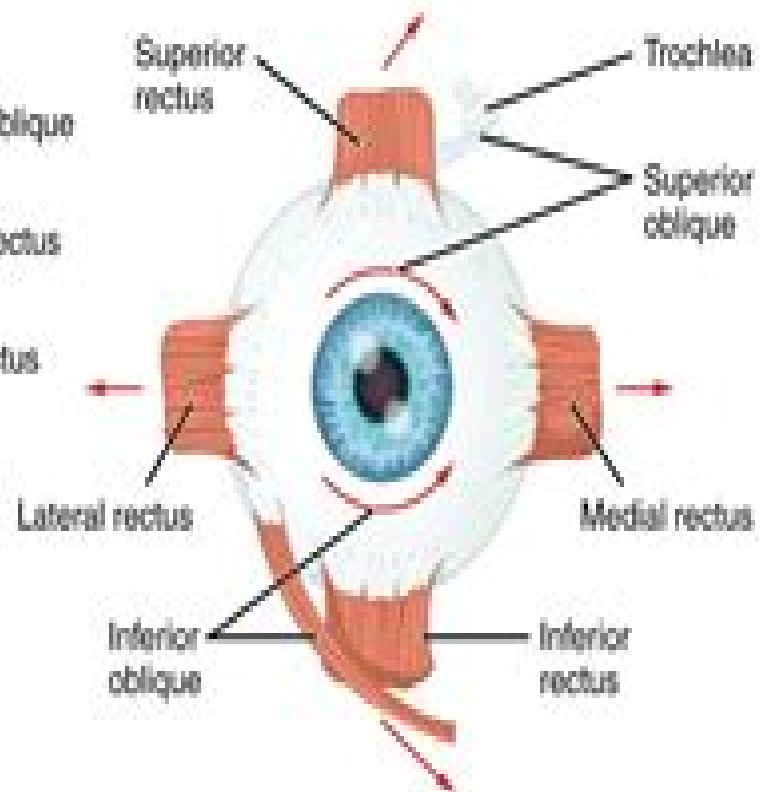




Lateral view of the right eye
