



The Digestive System

What is the digestive system?

The digestive system, or **gastrointestinal tract**, is a tract of organs that is used to break down food into nutrients that can be absorbed by the body. The digestive system is a complex system that includes the mouth, salivary glands, stomach, small intestine, large intestine, and rectum. The digestive system is a continuous tube that starts in the mouth and ends in the rectum. The organs of the digestive system are located in the abdominal cavity.

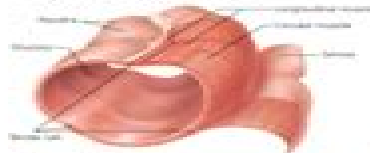


Liver, pancreas & gallbladder

After leaving the stomach, chyme moves into the duodenum, the first part of the small intestine, where it is mixed with bile secreted by the **liver** and pancreatic juice secreted by the **pancreas**. The liver is a large organ on the right side of the abdomen. The gallbladder is a small sac-like structure located just below the liver. The pancreas is a long, thin organ located behind the stomach.



Layers of large intestine



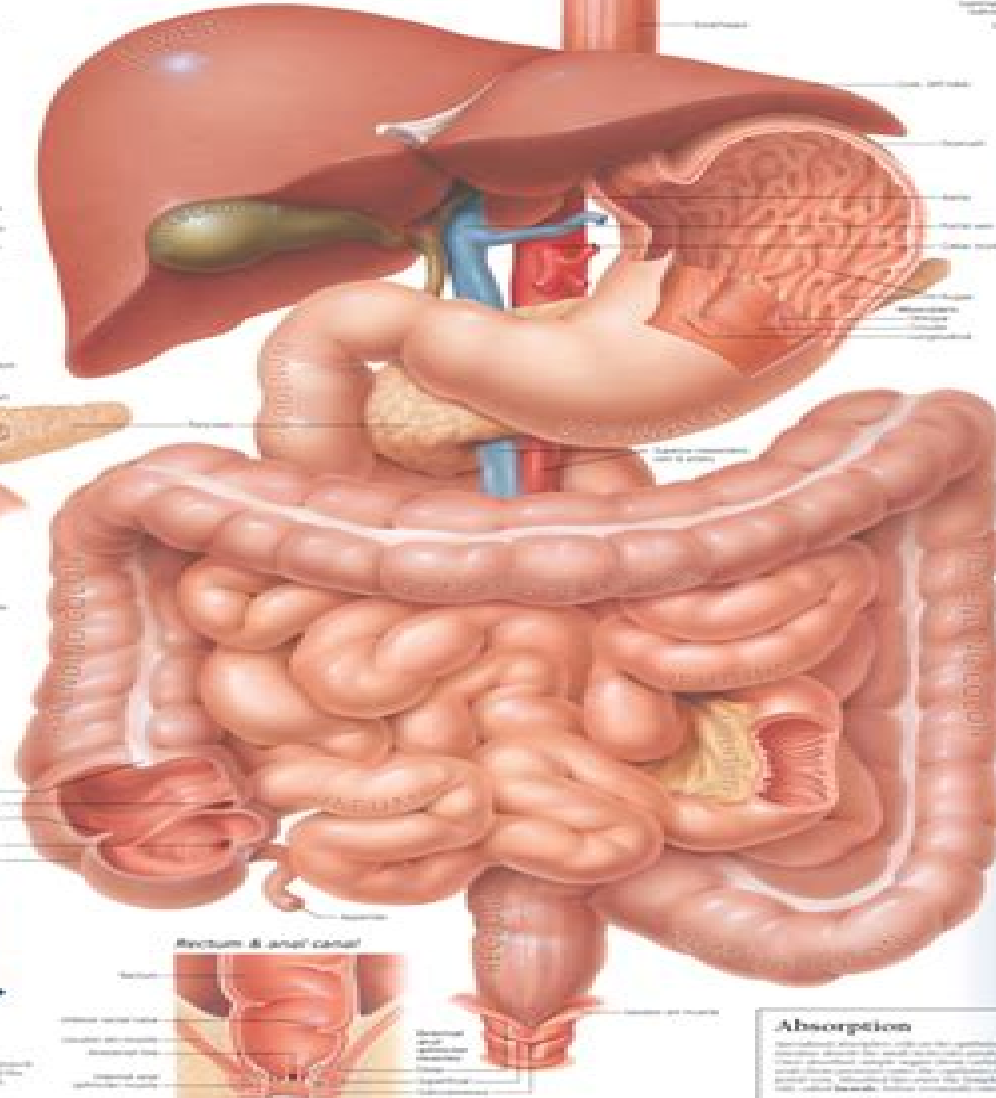
Large intestine

The large intestine consists of the cecum, the caecum, the ascending colon, the transverse colon, the descending colon, the sigmoid colon, and the rectum. The large intestine is responsible for absorbing water and electrolytes from the undigested food that enters it. It also forms and stores feces.



Peristaltic action

Food material is pushed through the digestive system by a series of powerful, rhythmic contractions called peristalsis. These contractions move the food forward and mix it with digestive juices, which are secreted by the stomach.



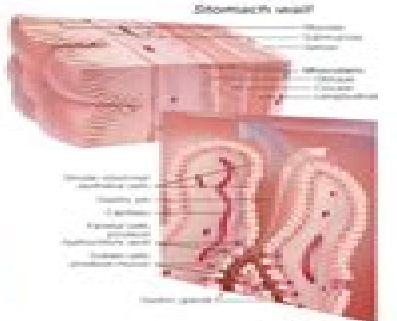
The mouth & salivary glands

Chewing the food breaks it into smaller pieces, making it easier to swallow. Saliva, secreted by the salivary glands, moistens the food and helps in the digestion of carbohydrates. The salivary glands are located in the mouth and neck. The major salivary glands are the parotid, submandibular, and sublingual glands.



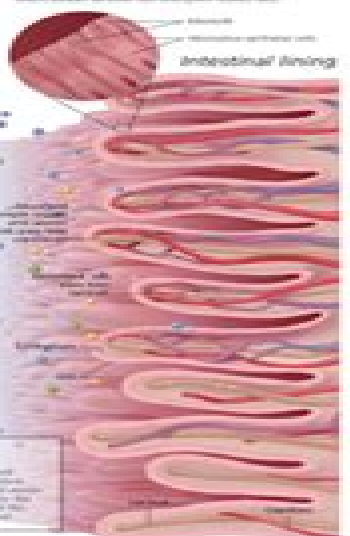
The stomach

The stomach is a J-shaped organ that is located in the upper left part of the abdomen. It is responsible for storing food and breaking it down into smaller pieces. The stomach wall is composed of several layers of muscle, which contract to mix food with gastric juices. The stomach also secretes hydrochloric acid, which helps in the digestion of proteins.



Small intestine

The small intestine is a long, coiled tube that is located in the lower part of the abdomen. It is responsible for the majority of the digestion of food. The small intestine is divided into three parts: the duodenum, the jejunum, and the ileum. The duodenum is the first part of the small intestine, where it receives food from the stomach. The jejunum is the middle part, and the ileum is the last part, which connects to the large intestine.



Absorption

The small intestine is the site of the absorption of the nutrients from the food. The villi, which are finger-like projections of the intestinal lining, increase the surface area for absorption. The nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream through the walls of the villi. The remaining material moves into the large intestine.
