The Cambridge Introduction to French Poetry Mary Lewis Shaw, 2003-08-14 Table of contents **Wordsworth's Poetry, 1815-1845** Tim Fulford, 2019-02-08 The later poetry of William Wordsworth popular in his lifetime and influential on the Victorians has with a few exceptions received little attention from contemporary literary critics In Wordsworth's Poetry 1815-1845 Tim Fulford argues that the later work reveals a mature poet far more varied and surprising than is often acknowledged Examining the most characteristic poems in their historical contexts he shows Wordsworth probing the experiences and perspectives of later life and innovating formally and stylistically He demonstrates how Wordsworth modified his writing in light of conversations with younger poets and learned to acknowledge his debt to women in ways he could not as a young man The older Wordsworth emerges in Fulford's depiction as a love poet of companionate tenderness rather than passionate lament He also appears as a political poet bitter at capitalist exploitation and at a society in which vanity is rewarded while poverty is blamed Most notably he stands out as a history poet more probing and more clear sighted than any of his time in his understanding of the responsibilities and temptations of all who try to memorialize the past

Howarth, 2024-09-17 Live performance has changed poetry more than anything else in the last hundred years it has given poets new audiences and a new economy and it has generated new styles from Imagism to confessional to contemporary Spoken Word But the creative impact that public reading had right through the twentieth century has not been well understood Mixing close listening to archive performances with intimate histories of modernist venues and promoters The Poetry Circuit tells the story of how poets met their audience again and how the feedback loops between their voices the venues and the occasions turned poems into running dramas between poet and listener A nervous T S Eliot reveals himself to be anything but impersonal while Marianne Moore's accident prone readings become subtle ways of keeping her poems in constant re draft Robert Frost used his poems to spar with his fans and rivals while Langston Hughes wrote Ask Your Mama to expose the prejudice circulating in the room as he spoke it The Poetry Circuit also shows how the post war reading boom made new kinds of poetry involving their audience and setting in the performance such as John Ashbery's anti charismatic Poets Theatre Amiri Baraka's documentary soundtracks of the streets or the confessional readings of Allen Ginsberg which shame the listeners more than the poet Covering the first seventy years of the poetry reading The Poetry Circuit demonstrates that there never were page and stage poets the reading simply changed what every modern poet could do

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Writer's Market, 1997, 1996 *The New Poet* Richard Danson Brown, 1999-04-01 This gracefully written and well thought out study deals with a neglected collection of poems by Spenser which was issued in 1591 at the height of his career While there has been a good deal written in recent years on two of the poems in the collection Mother Hubbard's Tale and Muiopotmos Brown innovatively addresses the collection in its entirety

He urges us to see it as a planned whole with a consistent design on the reader he fully acknowledges and even brings out further the heterogeneity of the collection but he examines it nevertheless as a sustained reflection on the nature of poetry and the auspices for writing in a modern world distancing itself from the traditions of the immediate past The strength of this work lies both in the originality of its project and in the precision and enterprise of the close reading that informs its argument Interest in the concern of Spenser's poetry with the nature of poetry is in the current critical mainstream but here the attentiveness is both unusually focused and unusually sustained Brown garners more than would be expected from the translations in the Complaints while at the same time including striking and individual chapters on the better known Mother Hubbard's Tale and Muiopotmos he advances understanding of these extremely subtle texts and fully justifies his wider approach to the collection as a whole Arguing that Spenser's relationship to literary tradition is more complex than is often thought Brown suggests that Spenser was a self-conscious innovator whose gradual move away from traditional poetics is exhibited by the different texts in the Complaints He further suggests that the Complaints are a poetics in practice which progress from traditional ideas of poetry to a new poetry that emerges through Spenser's transformation of traditional complaint

Plague Writing in Early Modern England Ernest B. Gilman, 2024-05-31 During the seventeenth century England was beset by three epidemics of the bubonic plague each outbreak claiming between a quarter and a third of the population of London and other urban centers Surveying a wide range of responses to these epidemics sermons medical tracts pious exhortations satirical pamphlets and political commentary *Plague Writing in Early Modern England* brings to life the many and complex ways Londoners made sense of such unspeakable devastation Ernest B Gilman argues that the plague writing of the period attempted unsuccessfully to rationalize the catastrophic and that its failure to account for the plague as an instrument of divine justice fundamentally threatened the core of Christian belief Gilman also trains his critical eye on the works of Jonson Donne Pepys and Defoe which he posits can be more fully understood when put into the context of this century long project to write out the plague Ultimately *Plague Writing in Early Modern England* is more than a compendium of artifacts of a bygone era it holds up a distant mirror to reflect our own condition in the age of AIDS super viruses multidrug resistant tuberculosis and the hovering threat of a global flu pandemic
