Because of the vital importance of human capital for economic growth, the World Bank has launched the Human Capital Project (HCP), which includes the Human Capital Index (HCI). The

objective of the HCP is to accelerate human capital development around the world The HCI is a cross country metric designed to measure and forecast a country's human capital Sri Lanka is a lower middle income country seeking to become an upper middle income country Developing human capital to a new and higher level will be central to achieving this development goal After the country's 26 year secessionist conflict ended in 2009 Sri Lanka's economy enjoyed rapid growth at an average rate of almost 6 percent between 2010 and 2017 reflecting a peace dividend and a determined policy thrust toward reconstruction and growth However in more recent years there have been signs of a slowdown The economy is transitioning from a predominantly rural economy to a more urbanized one In the context of the HCP and the HCI Sri Lanka Human Capital Development analyzes the main achievements and challenges of human capital development in this East Asia and Pacific island country in health and nutrition including stunting and in education including the challenges posed by Sri Lankans low participation in higher education The report concludes with a look at the importance of building a consensus among the public and other stakeholders to launch an ambitious human capital development program in Sri Lanka
