Monograph, Vocational Rehabilitation Series, 1918 A History of Disability Henri-Jacques Stiker, 1999 The increasing numbers of scholars policy makers and political activists who are concerned with questions of physical and cognitive disability will warmly welcome Henri Jacques Stiker's book the first to attempt to provide a framework for analyzing disability through the ages Published in 1997 in France as *Corps infirmes et sociétés* and available now in an excellent English translation the book traces the history of western cultural responses to disability from ancient times to the present In this volume Stiker examines a fundamental issue in contemporary Western discourse on disability the cultural assumption that equality sameness similarity is always desired by those in society He highlights the consequences of such a mindset illustrating the intolerance of diversity and individualism that arises from placing such importance on equality Importantly Stiker does not hesitate to assert his own stance on the issues he discusses that difference is not only acceptable but that it is desirable that it is necessary The author goes beyond anecdotal history to traverse a little known history penetrating to the heart of collective attitudes and reflecting on elements of policy The sweep is broad from a rereading and reinterpretation of the Oedipus myth to current legislation regarding disability he proposes an analytical history that demonstrates how societies reveal themselves through their attitudes towards disability at times in unexpected ways since the study of detail is often the best entry into the whole of a culture The book will be of interest to scholars of disability historians social scientists cultural anthropologists and those who are intrigued by the role that culture plays in the

Sport and the Female Disabled Body Elisabet Apelmo, 2016-10-04 This path breaking book analyses the experiences of young sporting women with physical impairments Taking phenomenology as a point of departure Elisabet Apelmo explores how the young women handle living with a body which on the one hand is viewed as deviant the disabled body and on the other hand is viewed as accomplished the sporting body A polarization is apparent between the weak which is manifested through the expression of belonging as we and the strong individual The subject position as strong positive and capable as a reaction towards the weak the negative is one of the few positions that are available to them Furthermore the book demonstrates the strategies of resistance the young women develop against the marginalisation stereotyping and othering they experience in their everyday lives Finally the author discusses the paradox of gender Disabled bodies are often seen as non gendered however these young women's experiences are structured by both the gender regimes within sports and the larger gender order of the society

Disability and Christian Theology Embodied Limits and Constructive Possibilities Deborah Beth Creamer, 2009-01-05 Attention to embodiment and the religious significance of bodies is one of the most significant shifts in contemporary theology In the midst of this however experiences of disability have received little attention This book explores possibilities for theological engagement with disability focusing on three

primary alternatives challenging existing theological models to engage with the disabled body considering possibilities for a disability liberation theology and exploring new theological options based on an understanding of the unsurprisingness of human limits The overarching perspective of this book is that limits are an unavoidable aspect of being human a fact we often seem to forget or deny Yet not only do all humans experience limits most of us also experience limits that take the form of disability at some point in our lives in this way disability is more normal than non disability If we take such experiences seriously and refuse to reduce them to mere instances of suffering we discover insights that are lost when we take a perfect or generic body as our starting point for theological reflections While possible applications of this insight are vast this work focuses on two areas of particular interest theological anthropology and metaphors for God This project challenges theology to consider the undeniable diversity of human embodiment It also enriches previous disability work by providing an alternative to the dominant medical and minority models both of which fail to acknowledge the full diversity of disability experiences Most notably this project offers new images and possibilities for theological construction that attend appropriately and creatively to diversity in human embodiment *This Kind of Child: The 'Disability' Story* K.
