For younger students, essential questions should be displayed in an obvious location and used as the large and easily viewed. They need to have pictures and illustrations incorporated into them. One should have student illustrations embedded with the essential questions.

Although we have added some simplified language in our essential questions, you will want to alter the word choice for some essential questions depending on your grade level.
