Veteran sports writer Terry Pluto asks Cleveland Browns fans Why after four decades of heartbreak teasing and futility do you still stick with this team Their stories coupled with Pluto s own insight and analysis deliver the answers Like any intense relationship it s complicated But these fans just won t give up *Making the Majors* Eric Leifer,2009-06-01 In this in depth look at major league sports Eric Leifer traces the growth and development of major leagues in baseball football basketball and hockey and predicts fundamental changes as the majors pursue international expansion He shows how every past expansion of sports publics has been accompanied by significant changes in the way sporting competition is organized With each reorganization the majors have created teams closer in ability bringing repetition to competition across time only to expand and energize the public s search for differences between teams and for events that disrupt the repetitive flow The phenomenal success of league sports Leifer writes rests on their ability to manufacture inequalities for fans to latch on to without jeopardizing the equalities that draw fans in Leifer supports his theory with historical detail and statistical analysis He examines the special concerns of league organizers in pursuing competitive balance and presents a detailed analysis of how large city domination has been undermined in the modern era of Major League Baseball Using games from the four major league sports he then shows how fans can themselves affect the course of competition In NFL football for example fans account for nearly all of the persisting inequality in team performance The possibility of sustaining inequality among equals emerges from the cross pressures that fans and leagues place on competition With substantial data in hand Leifer asks the essential question facing the leagues today how can they sustain a situation that depends entirely on simultaneous equality and contention one in which fan involvement may evaporate as soon as one team dominates His answer has significant implications for the future of major league sports both nationally and internationally **The American Football League** Ed Gruver,2011-01-14 Unable to buy into an existing team and rebuffed by National Football League owners who had no desire to expand 27 year old Lamar Hunt the son of Texas billionaire H L Hunt formed the American Football League in 1959 He placed his team in Dallas called them the Texans and invited other young entrepreneurs to join him The seven men who did called themselves members of the Foolish Club but on September 9 1960 the AFL made its regular season debut and went on to change the face of football forever Unlike the NFL the American Football League featured wide open offenses and innovative coaching strategies capturing a new generation of fans dedicated to the league and its players The AFL

aggressively pursued college stars Heisman Trophy winner Billy Cannon in its inaugural season and Joe Namath in 1965 The eight teams signed a collective television agreement that split the money equally among the franchises thus providing far more stability and balance than earlier start up leagues Based on interviews with owners coaches players scouts broadcasters and writers from the era this is a colorful account of the AFL and its place in sports history **Run to Glory and Profits** David George Surdam,2020-04-01 The National Football League has long reigned as America s favorite professional sports league In its early days however it was anything but a dominant sports industry barely surviving World War II Its rise began after the war and the 1950s was a pivotal decade for the league Run to Glory and Profits tells the economic story of how in one decade the NFL transformed from having a modest following in the Northeast to surpassing baseball as this country s most popular sport To break from the margins of the sports landscape pro football brought innovation action skill and episodic suspense on any given Sunday These factors in turn drove attendance and rising revenues Team owners were quick to embrace television as a new medium to put the league in front of a national audience Based on primary documents David George Surdam provides an economic analysis in telling the business story behind the NFL s rise to popularity Did the league s vaunted competitive balance in the decade result from its more generous revenue sharing and its reverse order draft How did the league combat rival leagues such as the All America Football Conference and the American Football League Although strife between owners and players developed quickly pro football fans stayed loyal because the product itself remained so good Pro Football in the 1960s Patrick Gallivan,2020-06-22 The 1960s were a tumultuous period in U S history and the sporting world was not immune to the decade s upturn of tradition As war in Southeast Asia civil unrest at home and political assassinations rocked the nation professional football struggled to attract fans While some players fought for civil rights and others fought overseas the ideological divides behind the protests and riots in the streets spilled into the locker rooms and athletes increasingly brought their political beliefs into the sports world This history describes how a decade of social upheaval affected life on the gridiron and the personalities and events that shaped the game The debut of the Super Bowl soon to become a fixture of American culture marked a professional sport on the rise Increasingly lucrative television contracts and innovations in the filming and broadcasting of games expanded pro football s audiences An authoritarian old guard best represented by the revered Vince Lombardi began to give way as star players like Joe Namath commanded new levels of pay and power And at last all teams fielded African American players belatedly beginning the correction of the sport s greatest wrong It Sounded Like a Good Idea at the Time Steve Fressle,2024-11-11 There is no information provided *Finding the Lost Year* Sondra Gordy,2009-02 Much has been written about the Little Rock School Crisis of 1957 but very little has been devoted to the following year the Lost Year 1958 59 when Little Rock schools were closed to all students both black and white Finding the Lost Year is the first book to look at the unresolved elements of the school desegregation crisis and how it turned into a community crisis when policymakers

thwarted desegregation and challenged the creation of a racially integrated community and when competing groups staked out agendas that set Arkansas's capital on a path that has played out for the past fifty years In Little Rock in 1958 3 665 students were locked out of a free public education Teachers lives were disrupted but students lives were even more confused Some were able to attend schools outside the city some left the state some joined the military some took correspondence courses but fully 50 percent of the black students went without any schooling Drawing on personal interviews with over sixty former teachers and students black and white Gordy details the long term consequences for students affected by events and circumstances over which they had little control *A Calendar of Campus Activities* John Howard McCoy, 1949

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
