CHARACTERISTICS OF THE BODY PLAN

- 1. **Unicellular** - Single-celled organisms.
- 2. **Multicellular** - Organisms made of many cells.
- 3. **Prokaryotic** - Cells without a nucleus.
- 4. **Eukaryotic** - Cells with a nucleus.

ORIENTATION TERMS

- 1. **Anterior** - Front of the body.
- 2. **Posterior** - Back of the body.
- 3. **Ventral** - Same as anterior.
- 4. **Dorsal** - Same as posterior.
- 5. **Superior** - Above.
- 6. **Inferior** - Below.
- 7. **Medial** - Towards the midline.
- 8. **Lateral** - Away from the midline.
- 9. **Proximal** - Closer to the point of attachment.
- 10. **Distal** - Further from the point of attachment.
- 11. **Superficial** - Closer to the surface.
- 12. **Deep** - Further from the surface.

BODY PARTS AND REGIONS

Head, Neck, Torso, Arms, Legs, Feet, etc.

NERVOUS SYSTEM

FUNCTIONS

- 1. **Control** - Directs the activities of the body.
- 2. **Coordination** - Brings about harmony between different parts of the body.
- 3. **Integration** - Processes information from the environment and the body.
- 4. **Communication** - Transmits information between different parts of the body.

STRUCTURE

- 1. **Brain** - The central control center.
- 2. **Spinal Cord** - The main communication pathway.
- 3. **Nerves** - Bundles of fibers that carry messages.

CELLS OF THE NERVOUS SYSTEM

- 1. **Neurons** - The basic units of the nervous system.
- 2. **Glial Cells** - Support cells that provide nutrients and protection.

INTERNAL SECRETORY SYSTEM

FUNCTIONS

- 1. **Regulation of Growth** - Controls the rate of cell division.
- 2. **Regulation of Metabolism** - Controls the rate of chemical reactions.
- 3. **Regulation of Reproduction** - Controls the development of sex cells.

STRUCTURE

- 1. **Endocrine Glands** - Glands that secrete hormones directly into the blood.
- 2. **Exocrine Glands** - Glands that secrete substances through ducts.

REGULATION OF GROWTH

Hormones like growth hormone, thyroxine, etc., regulate growth.

ORGAN SYSTEM OF THE BODY

- 1. **Integumentary System** - Skin, hair, nails.
- 2. **Muscular System** - Muscles.
- 3. **Skeletal System** - Bones, cartilage.
- 4. **Respiratory System** - Lungs, trachea.
- 5. **Digestive System** - Mouth, stomach, intestines.
- 6. **Circulatory System** - Heart, blood vessels.
- 7. **Excretory System** - Kidneys, ureters, bladder.
- 8. **Reproductive System** - Ovaries, testes.
- 9. **Endocrine System** - Endocrine glands.
- 10. **Nervous System** - Brain, spinal cord, nerves.

- 1. **Organization** - From simple to complex.
- 2. **Metabolism** - Chemical reactions in the body.
- 3. **Reproduction** - Production of new individuals.

- 5. **Response to Stimuli** - Reaction to changes in the environment.

COMPONENTS OF ANATOMY

- 1. **Structure** - The form and organization of the body.
- 2. **Function** - The activities performed by the body.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

FUNCTIONS

- 1. **Gas Exchange** - Taking in oxygen and releasing carbon dioxide.
- 2. **Acid-Base Balance** - Maintaining the pH of the blood.

STRUCTURE

- 1. **Lungs** - The organs where gas exchange occurs.
- 2. **Trachea** - The windpipe.
- 3. **Diaphragm** - The muscle that contracts and relaxes to breathe.

- 1. **Hormones** - Chemical messengers.
- 2. **Endocrine Glands** - Glands that secrete hormones.
