The present volume explores another natural interface of developmental psychobiology: behavioral ecology. It documents the progress made by developmental psychobiologists since the mid 1970s in identifying capacities of learning and conditioning in birds and mammals during the very moments following birth, indeed during the antenatal period. These breakthroughs in a field that had previously lain dormant reflect the need to meet the infant where it is in order for behavior to emerge. Accordingly, studies have been conducted at nest temperature; infants have been rewarded by opportunities to huddle, suckle, or obtain milk; behaviors that are normally engaged in the nest. In addition, there was rejection of the excessive deprivation, extreme handling, and traumatic manipulation studies of the 1950s and 1960s that yielded information on how animals could respond to trauma but did not reveal mechanisms of normal development. In their place has arisen a series of analyses of how naturally occurring stimuli and situations gain control over behavior and how specifiable experiences impose limitations on subsequent development. Constraints were identified on the range of interactions that remained available to developing animals as a result of particular events.

In this 1992 book John Kennedy's point is that explicit anthropomorphism was well nigh killed by fierce criticism from the radical Behaviourists but that we have to recognize that today there is a new anthropomorphism which is much harder to avoid because it is unintended and largely unconscious. For that reason even those who if they were asked would firmly reject anthropomorphism nevertheless unwittingly slip into it from time to time. This book contains nineteen essays on behavioural concepts which have seldom been identified as anthropomorphic but in fact bear that connotation and lead to mistakes. Some of these such as search images in birds and the learning of grammatical language by apes have been seen through as errors after a time. A greater number such as efferece copy goal directedness cognition and suffering in animals are still current though not yet regarded as erroneous. The final chapter outlines things we can do to minimise the damage it does to the causal analysis of animal behaviour.

Origins of Psychopathology Horacio Fabrega (Jr.), 2002 What are the origins of human psychopathology? Is mental illness a relatively recent phenomenon or has it been with us throughout evolution? In *Origins of Psychopathology* Horacio Fabrega Jr employs principles of evolutionary biology to better understand the significance of mental illness. He explores whether what psychiatry has categorized as mental disorders could have existed during earlier phases of human evolution. Fabrega approaches the prominent features of mental disorders as adaptive responses to the environment and life's circumstances which in turn can only be understood in the context of our evolutionary past. Taking his cue from theoretical issues raised by research into primate behavior and early hominid evolution he poses the question: What if any aspects of mental illness are rooted in our evolution? Does mental illness occur in primates and other animals and if so what does this tell us about mental illness in human evolution? How has mental illness played an adaptive role? How has the development of language and higher cognitive functions affected characteristics of psychopathology? Fabrega synthesizes insights from both the clinical and the evolutionary points of view. This facet of psychopathology which involves its origins and manifestations viewed across the expanse of human evolution has until now been largely neglected in psychiatric education, theory and practice.
