A. Main Idea: The 1950s was a decade of prosperity, with people moving to the suburbs, buying new products, and working in offices.

- Detail:** Americans produced an abundance of goods and services because of New techniques and technology.
- Detail:** Many Americans moved to the suburbs to avoid the crime and congestion of city neighborhoods.
- Detail:** From 1945 to 1961, the the birthrate exploded. Some contributing factors of the baby boom were: GI benefits encouraged the growth and popular celebrated large families.

B. Main Idea: American scientists broke new ground in the areas of electronics, manufacturing, and medicine.

- Detail:** In electronics, the development of the transistor made radios smaller and portable; the development of the computer launched a revolution, and the development of the jet made airline travel available to many.
- Detail:** The development of powerful antibiotics and vaccines made infections much more treatable.
- Detail:** Scientist Salk developed an injectable vaccine to prevent polio. Later, the the Sabin vaccine became the common method of prevention.

C. Main Idea: As television became popular, other forms of entertainment had to adapt in order to survive.

- Detail:** By 1957, nearly 80% percent percent of families had at least one television. Popular formats included comedy, variety shows, and action programs.
- Detail:** The Automobiles saved the radio industry as commuters listened in transit.
