busybody is another important figure in Avonlea As Anne starts her teaching job she has rose tinted ideas of what a schoolteacher might accomplish Anne believes it is morally wrong to whip a child when they have misbehaved She plans to win all her students over with her theory of kindness by talking to them and reasoning with them Most of Anne s friends do not believe her approach will be effective
