Perez, Jr., 2008-01-27 Cuban Studies 38 examines topics that include liberalism emanating from Havana in the early 1800s Jose Martí's theory of psychocoloniality the relationship between sugar planters insurgents and the Spanish military during the revolution new aesthetics in Cuban cinema the recovery of poet Jos Angel Buesa and the meaning of Eli n Gonzales in the context of life in Miami *Free Pages and Hard Times* Manuel González, 2003-03-13 Manuel Gonz lez Prada was a powerful Peruvian writer and political reformer whose essays and speeches influenced generations of young radicals He founded the Party of National Unity in 1891 was linked to the anarchist movement and served as Director of the National Library from 1912 1914 His writings have had enormous impact on the literary and political life of Peru taking up the defense of exploited indigenous people broadsiding the landowning oligarchy and denouncing the social and political errors of the country In fact the radical politics Prada advocated then are still alive and relevant today Modernization secularization of Peru transformation of a nation through its people promotion of internationalism universalism versus overt patriotism communitarianism and condemnation of war This translation is based on the Obras of Gonz lez Prada edited by Luis Alberto S nchez It includes essays speeches and polemical writings drawn from two of Prada's only books of prose published during his lifetime *Paginas Libres* and *Horas de Lucha* in addition to unpublished manuscripts and works previously printed in newspapers and magazines His writings are gathered thematically under the subheadings Peruvian Problems Anarchy and Philosophical Literary and Linguistic Problems *Tesoro de los prosadores españoles* Don Eugenio De Ochoa, 2022-05-05 Reimpresi n del original primera publicaci n en 1841 *Inventing the Recording* Eva Moreda Rodríguez, 2021 *Inventing the Recording* focuses on the decades in which recorded sound went from a technological possibility to a commercial and cultural artefact Through the analysis of a specific and unique national context author Eva Moreda Rodr guez tells the stories of institutions and individuals in Spain and discusses the development of discourses and ideas in close connection with national concerns and debates all while paying close attention to original recordings from this era The book starts with the arrival in Spain of notices about Edison's invention of the phonograph in 1877 followed by the first demonstrations of the invention 1878 1882 by scientists and showmen These demonstrations greatly stimulated the imagination of scientists journalists and playwrights who spent the rest of the 1880s speculating about the phonograph and its potential to revolutionize society once it was properly developed and marketed The book then moves on to analyse the traveling phonographs and salones fonogr ficos of the 1890s and early 1900s with phonographs being paraded around Spain and exhibited in group listening sessions in theatres private homes and social spaces pertaining to different social classes Finally the book covers the development of an indigenous recording industry dominated by the so called gabinetes fonogr ficos small businesses that sold imported phonographs produced their own recordings and shaped early discourses about commercial phonography and the record as a commodity between 1896 and 1905 The End of the

of conquest through literature and cinema The Origins of Spanish Colonialism in Morocco, 1859-62 Itzea Goikolea-Amiano, 2025-01-21 This book investigates the beginnings of Spanish colonialism in Morocco in the mid nineteenth century focusing on the Spanish invasion of northern Morocco and the twenty seven month occupation of the city of Tetouan from 1859 to 1862 By homing in on specific events scenes and records the book reveals both the micro processes of everyday life and the larger systems of beliefs values and representations informing them It scrutinises the contours of the incipient Hispano Moroccan modern colonial formation by recourse to comparative analysis of dynamics across the Islamicate Mediterranean and Atlantic worlds while also emphasising the importance of local notions spaces and peoples in the modelling of colonial epistemologies and practices The author adopts different disciplinary approaches questions the

dominant modes of historical knowledge production and explores colonial power from a feminist intersectional perspective thus acknowledging the polysemic nature of colonial rule for different historical subjects including the lower class and female subalterns

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
