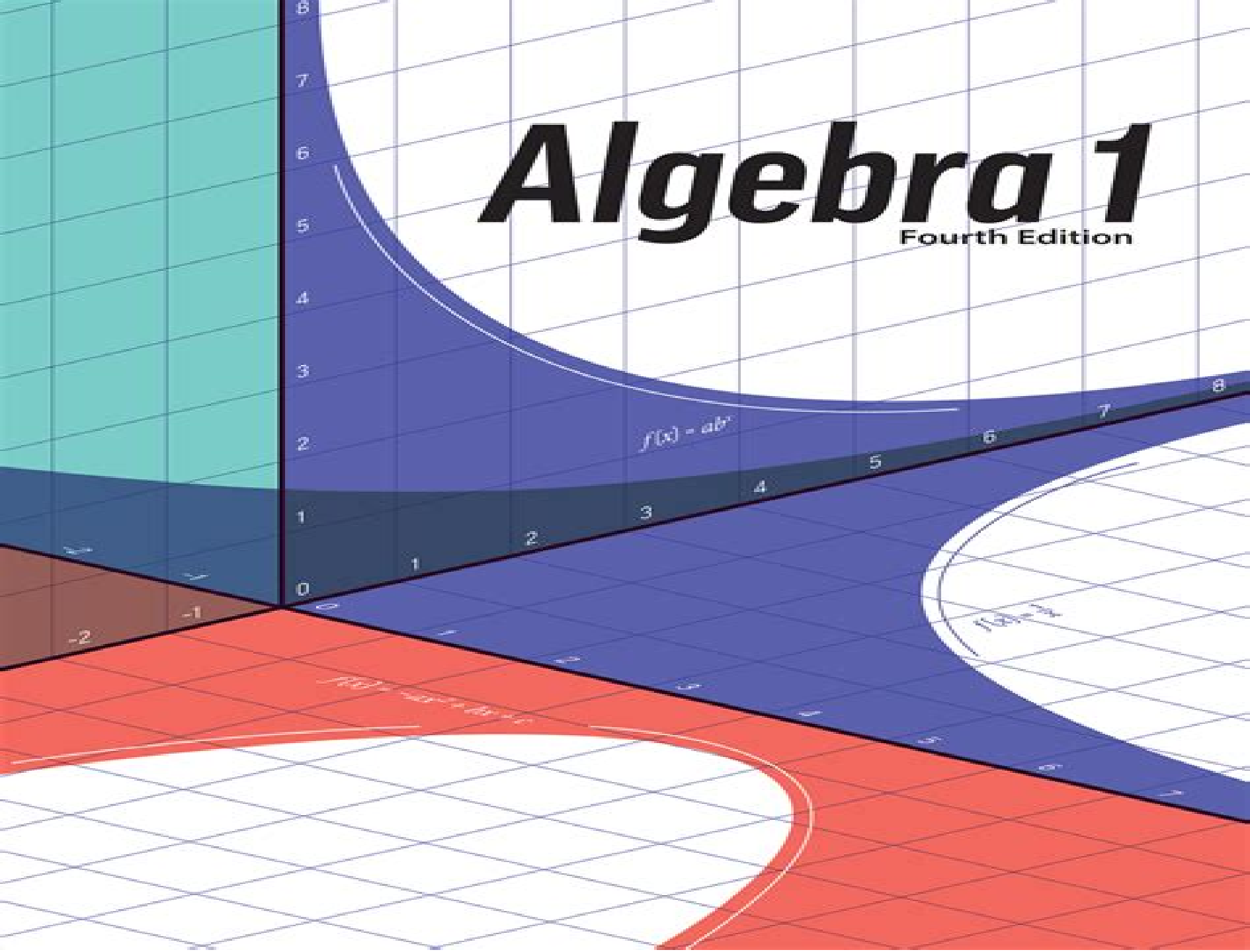

early career teachers experience with how students think when doing algebra in middle or high school as well as to supplement veteran teachers knowledge of content and students The research that this book is based upon can provide teachers with insight into the nature of a student s struggles with particular algebraic ideas to help teachers identify patterns that imply underlying thinking Our book *How Students Think When Doing Algebra* is not intended to be a how to book for teachers Instead it is intended to orient new teachers to the ways students think and be a book that teachers at all points in their career continually pull of the shelf when they wonder how might my students struggle with this algebraic concept I am about to teach The primary audience for this book is early career mathematics teachers who don t have extensive experience working with students engaged in mathematics However the book can also be useful to veteran teachers to supplement their knowledge and is an ideal resource for mathematics educators who are preparing preservice teachers
