



American Government Chapter 12

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The Speaker of the House....	Is both the elected presiding officer of the House and the acknowledged leader of its majority party. Duties: To preside and keep order.
Duties of the President of the Senate are....	To recognize members and put questions to a vote.
The party whips....	Are assistant floor leaders.
A Party caucus....	Meets before Congress convenes in January and occasionally during a session. Deals mostly with matters of party organization, I.E. The selection of the party's floor leaders and questions of committee memberships.
Committee chairman....	Head the standing committees in each chamber and decide when their committees will meet, which bills they will take up, whether they will hold public hearings, and what witnesses the committee should call. Also manages debate and decides its final course of action.
Standing committees.....	Consider most bills and are very influential on the outcome of the bills.
Select committees play the role of....	Investigator and are set up for a certain purpose. Members are appointed by The Speaker of the House and The President of the Senate.
Joint committees...	Are sometimes set up for a temporary but most are permanent. Some are investigative and issue periodic reports on the House and Senate. Most have routine duties such as the Joint Committee on the Library of Congress.
Conference committees....	Sort out the differences between the House and Senate on a bill.
Public bills.....	Apply to the nation as a whole I.E. A tax measure or an amendment to the copyright laws.
Private bills.....	Are measures that apply to certain persons or places rather than to an entire nation. I.E. A grant to a rancher.
A rider is....	Something dealing with an unrelated subject that is added to a bill.
The Committee of the Whole...	Is a different form of the house and speeds up the deciding process of a bill.
A discharge position....	Enables members to force a bill that has remained in committee 30 days onto the floor for consideration.
A filibuster....	Is an attempt to "talk a bill to death"
A Cloture....	Limits debate, to speed up the process of debate on a bill.
If a President vetos a bill, Congress.....	May pass the bill on the two-thirds vote or amend the bill and resend it to the President.
A pocket veto...	Happens when Congress adjourns its session within ten days of submitting the bill to the President and the President does not act, the measure dies.
