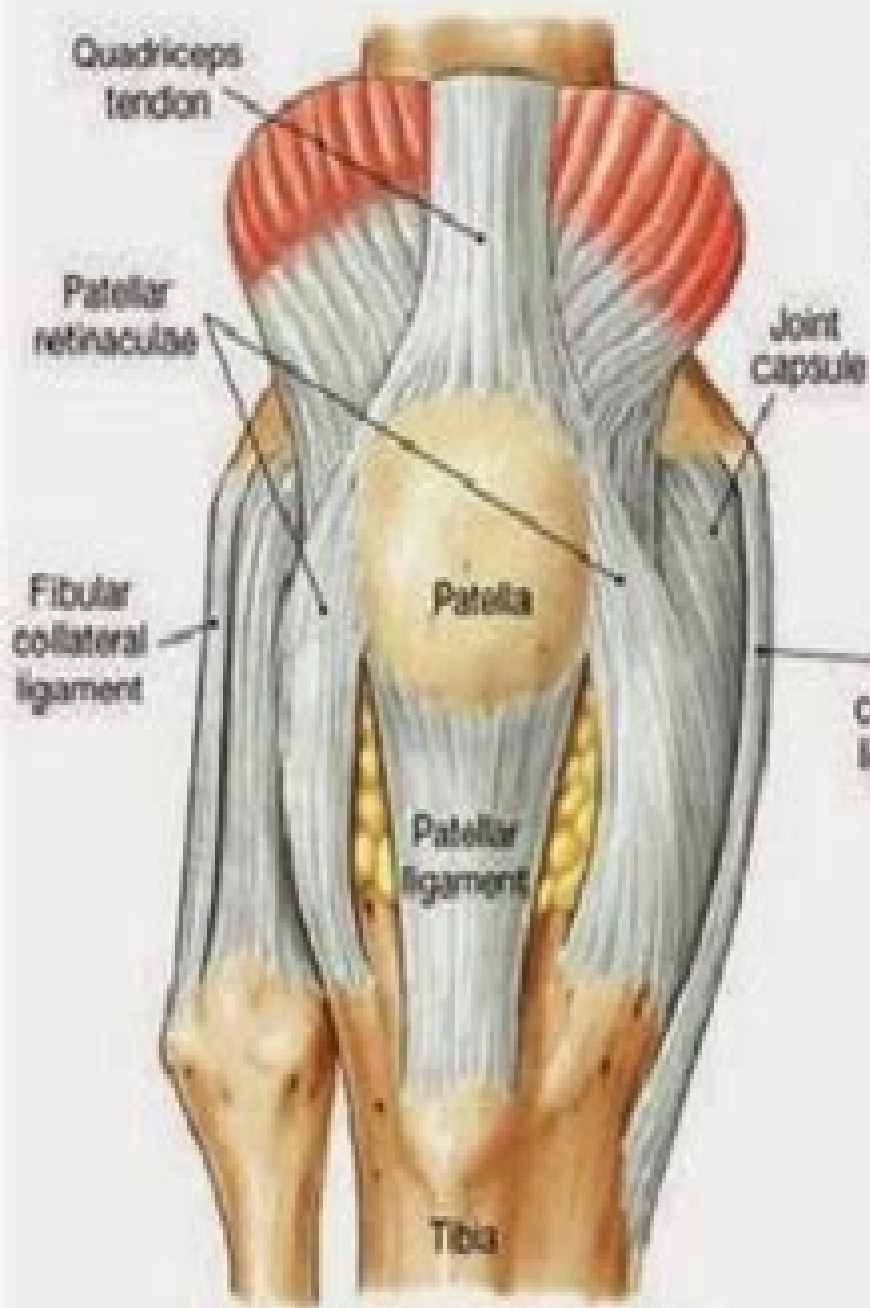




(a) Anterior view, superficial layer
