using individual masks for each foot strike Producing a 54 subject database from which the normal behavior of the foot could be quantified The group showed a surprisingly low right foot step off dominance of only 54% The combination of the radius of gyration and impulse in particular produces a succinct but powerful summary of the footprint during dynamic activity.
