1.  **radius 4 cm, height 6 cm**
 Volume: $V = \frac{1}{3}\pi r^2 h = \frac{1}{3}\pi (4)^2 (6) = 32\pi \approx 100.5$ cm³

2.  **length 8 cm, width 4 cm, height 3 cm**
 Volume: $V = lwh = (8)(4)(3) = 96$ cm³

3.  **radius 3 cm**
 Volume: $V = \frac{4}{3}\pi r^3 = \frac{4}{3}\pi (3)^3 = 36\pi \approx 113.1$ cm³

4.  **radius 5 cm, height 7 cm**
 Volume: $V = \frac{1}{3}\pi r^2 h = \frac{1}{3}\pi (5)^2 (7) = \frac{175}{3}\pi \approx 183.3$ cm³

Milman, Vladimir Pestov, Nicole Tomczak-Jaegermann, 2013-03-27 Asymptotic Geometric Analysis is concerned with the geometric and linear properties of finite dimensional objects normed spaces and convex bodies especially with the asymptotics of their various quantitative parameters as the dimension tends to infinity The deep geometric probabilistic and combinatorial methods developed here are used outside the field in many areas of mathematics and mathematical sciences The Fields Institute Thematic Program in the Fall of 2010 continued an established tradition of previous large scale programs devoted to the same general research direction The main directions of the program included Asymptotic theory of convexity and normed spaces Concentration of measure and isoperimetric inequalities optimal transportation approach Applications of the concept of concentration Connections with transformation groups and Ramsey theory Geometrization of probability Random matrices Connection with asymptotic combinatorics and complexity theory These directions are represented in this volume and reflect the present state of this important area of research It will be of benefit to researchers working in a wide range of mathematical sciences in particular functional analysis combinatorics convex geometry dynamical systems operator algebras and computer science

Milman, 2015-06-18 The authors present the theory of asymptotic geometric analysis a field which lies on the border between geometry and functional analysis In this field isometric problems that are typical for geometry in low dimensions are substituted by an isomorphic point of view and an asymptotic approach as dimension tends to infinity is introduced Geometry and analysis meet here in a

non trivial way Basic examples of geometric inequalities in isomorphic form which are encountered in the book are the isomorphic isoperimetric inequalities which led to the discovery of the concentration phenomenon one of the most powerful tools of the theory responsible for many counterintuitive results A central theme in this book is the interaction of randomness and pattern At first glance life in high dimension seems to mean the existence of multiple possibilities so one may expect an increase in the diversity and complexity as dimension increases However the concentration of measure and effects caused by convexity show that this diversity is compensated and order and patterns are created for arbitrary convex bodies in the mixture caused by high dimensionality The book is intended for graduate students and researchers who want to learn about this exciting subject Among the topics covered in the book are convexity concentration phenomena covering numbers Dvoretzky type theorems volume distribution in convex bodies and more *Mixed Metals* Arthur Horseman Hiorns,1890
