

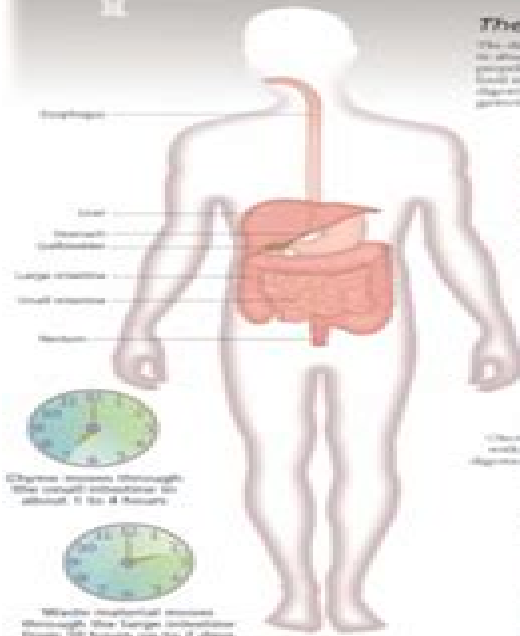

The Digestive Process

The digestive system

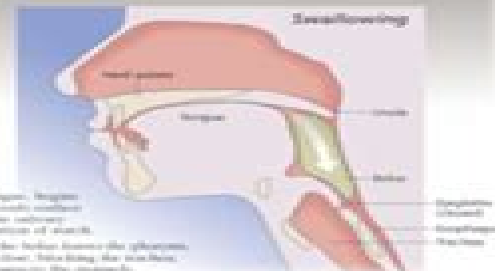
The digestive system, or gastrointestinal tract, is essentially a muscular tube in which most digestion, absorption of nutrients, and elimination takes place. Food enters the mouth voluntarily or reflexively, is propelled through a series of different accessory and absorptive components. Within these components, food is digested (broken down) by digestive enzymes and components must change to be absorbed. The digestive system also stores undigested components until they are ready to be expelled at the end of the gastrointestinal tract.



Ingestion

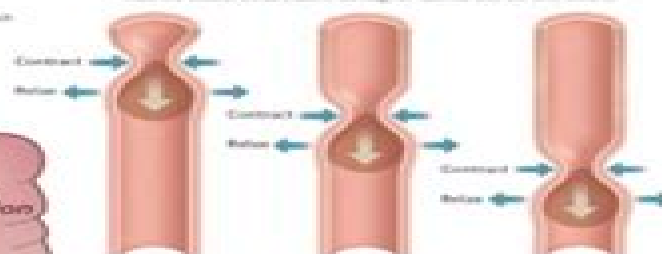
Chewing & swallowing

Chewing, the mechanical action of the mouth and tongue, begins the breakdown of solid food. This greatly increases food's surface area and exposes the food more fully to enzymes of the salivary glands. Saliva softens the food and begins the digestion of starch. The mixture of food and saliva is called a *bolus*. In the bolus, food is pushed by the tongue, a flap-like valve, and the vocal cord, forcing the bolus through the esophagus where muscular bolus through the esophagus to the stomach.



Peristaltic action

Material is moved through the digestive system by a series of smooth muscle contractions called peristalsis. The muscle is relaxed the material continues, while the muscle ahead contracts, forcing the material into the next section.

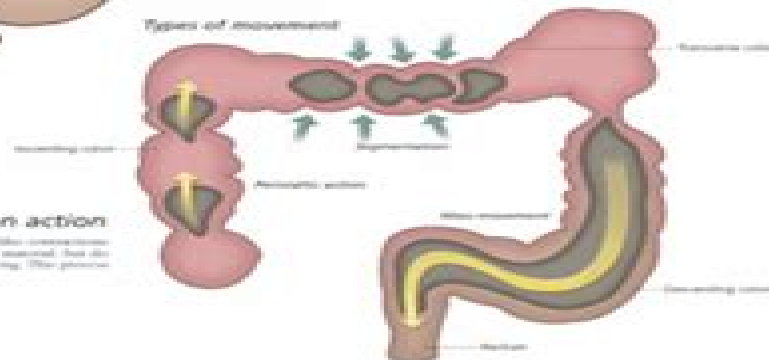


In the esophagus, material moves through the large intestine, water and electrolytes are absorbed (reabsorbed). This remaining mass is moved forward and regular contractions.

Colonic movement

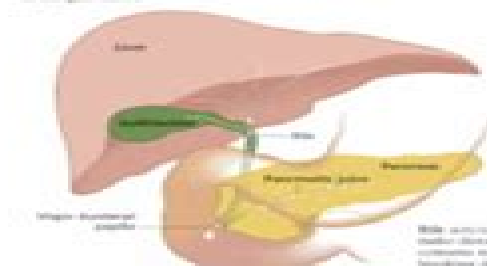
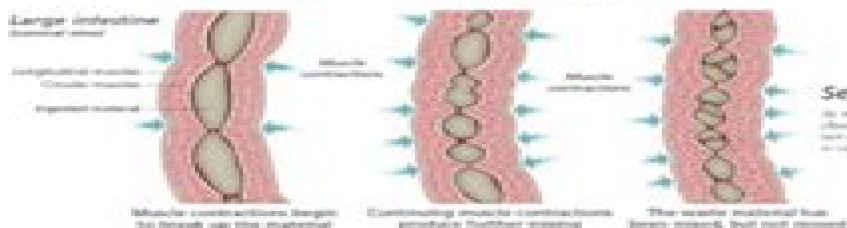
Movement through the large intestine is accomplished through the contractions of the longitudinal and circular muscles. Types of movement include peristaltic action, segmental contractions, and mass movement. Movement of food through the large intestine is slower than through the small intestine, allowing for reabsorption of water.

Segmentation action

In regular intervals, ring-like contractions (haustra) and relax the water material, then the water is absorbed, leaving the protein in called segmentation.



Bile enters the small intestine and helps to break down fats into smaller particles. Bile also helps to emulsify fats into smaller particles. Bile also helps to break down fats, proteins and carbohydrates.
