 - Endosteum: inner membrane lining of medullary cavity
 - Medullary cavity: site of bone growth / repair
 - Periosteum: outer bone lining. Also has blood vessels and nerves, and attachment site for ligaments / tendons
 - Articular cartilage: covers the ends of bones that participate in joints
