

Organ system	Organs and structures	Basic function
<i>Integumentary</i>	<i>Skin, hair, nails</i>	<i>Protection of deeper tissue, manufacture of vitamin D, maintaining temperature balance.</i>
<i>Skeletal</i>	<i>Bones, cartilage, joints</i>	<i>Protects organs, movement, posture, blood cell formation, mineral storage</i>
<i>Muscular</i>	<i>Smooth, cardiac, skeletal</i>	<i>Movement, heat production, blood vessel size, heart contraction, movement of gastro-intestinal tract</i>
<i>Nervous</i>	<i>Nerve cells, nerve fibres</i>	<i>Fast acting control system of the body, activates muscles and glands, responds to external stimuli</i>
<i>Endocrine</i>	<i>Glands – thyroid, pineal, parathyroid, pancreas, hypothalamus, pituitary, adrenal, testes, ovaries</i>	<i>Slow acting control system of body, growth, reproduction, metabolism</i>
<i>Cardiovascular</i>	<i>Heart, arteries, veins, capillaries</i>	<i>Oxygenate the blood and transport materials around the body(oxygen, carbon dioxide, nutrients, wastes)</i>
<i>Lymphatic and immune</i>	<i>Lymph nodes, lymphatic vessels, lymphatic capillaries, lymphatic organs, white blood cells</i>	<i>Return lost fluid back to blood, immunity, fat absorption</i>
<i>Urinary</i>	<i>Kidneys, bladder, ureter, urethra</i>	<i>Remove waste from blood, regulate acid/base balance, regulate oxygen levels, regulate blood pressure, regulate electrolytes</i>
<i>Respiratory</i>	<i>Lungs, diaphragm, trachea, bronchi,</i>	<i>Allow for diffusion of oxygen into blood and carbon dioxide out</i>
<i>Digestive</i>	<i>Mouth, esophagus, stomach small intestine, large intestine, liver, pancreas</i>	<i>Digestion of food, absorption of nutrients into the body, elimination of waste</i>
<i>Reproductive</i>	<i>Ovaries, uterus, fallopian tubes, vagina, mammary glands, testes, prostate, penis, scrotum, seminal vesicles</i>	<i>Production of offspring</i>
