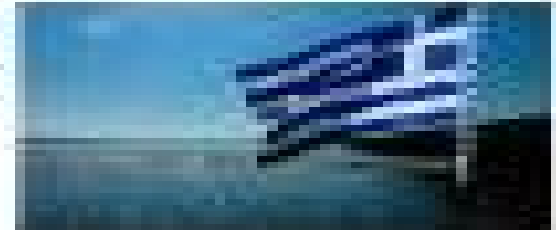


Ancient Greece Webquest
