Vocabulary

- a. **Holocaust:** Refers to the systematic genocide carried out by Adolf Hitler's Nazi regime during World War II. Six million Jews, along with millions of others, were persecuted and murdered during the Holocaust.
- b. **Anti-Semitism:** Prejudice, discrimination, or hostility directed against Jews. Anti-Semitism played a significant role in the Holocaust.
- c. **Nazi Germany:** The period from 1933 to 1945 when Germany was under the dictatorship of Adolf Hitler and the National Socialist German Workers' Party (Nazi Party). It was during this time that the Holocaust occurred.
- d. **Concentration Camp:** Detention centers established by the Nazi regime where millions of Jews and other minority groups were imprisoned, forced into labor, and often killed.
- e. **Anne Frank:** A Jewish girl who went into hiding with her family during the Holocaust and wrote a diary, which was later published as "The Diary of a Young Girl." Anne Frank's diary provides a firsthand account of the life of Jews in hiding during the Holocaust.
- f. **Anne Frank House:** The building in Amsterdam where Anne Frank and her family hid from the Nazis. Today, it is a museum dedicated to Anne Frank's life and the Holocaust.
- g. **Righteous Among the Nations:** A title given by the State of Israel to non-Jews who risked their lives to save Jews during the Holocaust. These individuals are recognized for their acts of courage and humanity.
- h. **Genocide:** The deliberate and systematic extermination of a national, ethnic, racial, or religious group. The Holocaust is one of the most infamous examples of genocide in history.
