Traditional	- Economic decisions are based on customs, traditions, and beliefs. - Little to no specialization of labor. - Barter system is common. - Resources are allocated based on the needs of the community. - Limited economic growth and innovation.
Market	- Economic decisions are made by individuals and businesses. - Specialization of labor is common. - Prices are determined by supply and demand. - Private property rights are protected.- Competition encourages innovation and efficiency. - Limited government intervention.
Command	- Economic decisions are made by the government. - Little to no private property rights.- Central planning determines production and distribution of goods. - Little to no competition. - Limited consumer choice. - Limited innovation and economic growth.
Mixed	- Economic decisions are made by both the government and individuals/businesses. - Private property rights are protected. - Government regulates certain industries and provides public goods and services. - Market forces determine prices and allocation of resources. - Some level of government intervention to address market failures and promote social welfare.
