Gorbachev's New Thinking and Third World Conflicts Jiří Valenta, Frank Cibulka, Some of the most crucial changes inspired by Gorbachev and perestroika concern Soviet and East European policies toward Third World countries. Despite countless studies of Soviet U S relations and U S relations with the Third World, the area of Soviet relations with the Third World has been left relatively undeveloped. This is the first of several volumes intended to add to our knowledge of what the series editor Jiri Valenta characterizes as East South relations. In this new era of cooperation and diplomacy, the superpowers are working to resolve regional conflicts in and around Afghanistan, Nicaragua, Angola, and Cambodia. Such efforts are exceedingly complex since they necessarily involve not only the Soviet Union but Third World nations that may operate independently, such as Cuba and Vietnam. This volume addresses a number of such conflicts. In addition to those already mentioned, conflicts in Ethiopia, Namibia, and the Philippines are discussed, and their implications for Western policy makers are reviewed. As the contributors emphasize, despite current Soviet emphasis on peaceful solutions to regional conflicts, Gorbachev's New Thinking in foreign affairs is still decidedly selective. In some cases, the Soviet Union will actually encourage close ties with regional Third World powers, as it has with India. It is also too much to expect that the Soviet Union, much less Cuba and Vietnam, will completely cut ties to revolutionary allies worldwide. That said, the 1990s will undoubtedly be characterized by new Soviet foreign policy styles. Their shape and form is the subject of this book. It will be of immense interest to policymakers and researchers concerned about current developments in relations between the superpowers and with the Third World. of ten original essays provides a showcase of currently diverse theoretical agendas in the field of international relations. Contributors address the theoretical analysis that their perspective brings to the issue of change in global politics. Written for readers with a general interest in and knowledge of world affairs, *New Thinking in International Relations Theory* can also be assigned in international relations theory courses. The volume begins with an essay on the classical tradition at the end of the Cold War. Essays explore work outside the mainstream such as Jean Bethke Elshtain on feminist theory and James Der Derian on postmodern theory as well as those developing theoretical advances within traditional realms from James DeNardo's formal modeling to the more descriptive analyses of Miles Kahler and Steve Weber. Other essays include Matthew Evangelista on domestic structure, Daniel Deudney on naturalist and geopolitical theory, and Joseph Grieco on international structuralist theory.

False Dawn Lee Penn, 2004. The interfaith movement which began with the 1893 World's Parliament of Religions in Chicago has grown worldwide. Although this movement has been largely unknown to the public, it now provides a spiritual face for globalization, the economic and political forces leading us all from nationalism to One World. The most ambitious organization in today's interfaith movement is the United Religions Initiative (URI) founded by William Swing, the Episcopal Bishop of California. Investigative reporter Lee Penn, a Catholic ex-Marxist, exhaustively documents the history and beliefs of the URI and its New Age and globalist allies, the vested interests that support these movements, and the direction they appear to be taking. The interfaith movement is no longer merely the province of a coterie of little-heeded religious idealists with grandiose visions. The URI's proponents have ranged from billionaire George Soros to President George W. Bush, from the far right Rev. Sun Myung Moon to the liberal Catholic theologian Hans Küng, and from the Dalai Lama to the leaders of government-approved Protestant churches in the People's Republic of China. The interfaith movement, including the URI, is being promoted by globalist and New Age reformers who favor erosion of national sovereignty, marginalization of traditional religions, establishment of global governance, and creation of a new Earth-based global spirituality in effect a one-world religion. Therefore, the URI and the interfaith movement are poised to become the spiritual foundation of the New World Order, the new civilization now proposed by Mikhail Gorbachev, the last leader of the Soviet Union. In *The Reign of Quantity and the Signs of the Times*, French metaphysician René Guénon spoke of the anti-tradition, the forces of materialism and secular humanism finally giving way to the counter-tradition, the satanic inversion of true spirituality leading to the regime of Antichrist. The anti-tradition weakens and dissolves traditional spiritualities, after which the counter-tradition sets up a counterfeit in their place. Since Guénon's time, as is well known, anti-traditional forces have greatly advanced worldwide. It is less well known that counter-traditional movements have also made great strides and now stand closer to the centers of global political and religious power than ever before. The counter-tradition is making inroads on the political and cultural Right as much as it is doing on the Left. *False Dawn* painstakingly documents these trends and speculates on their future development. In so doing, the author takes investigative reporting to the threshold of prophecy and

Disruption Michael De Groot, 2024-03-15 In *Disruption* Michael De Groot argues that the global economic upheaval of the 1970s was decisive in ending the Cold War Both the West and the Soviet bloc struggled with the slowdown of economic growth chaos in the international monetary system inflation shocks in the commodities markets and the emergence of offshore financial markets The superpowers had previously disseminated resources to their allies to enhance their own national security but the disappearance of postwar conditions during the 1970s forced Washington and Moscow to choose between promoting their own economic interests and supporting their partners in Europe and Asia De Groot shows that new unexpected macroeconomic imbalances in global capitalism sustained the West during the following decade Rather than a creditor nation and net exporter as it had been during the postwar period the United States became a net importer of capital and goods during the 1980s that helped fund public spending stimulated economic activity and lubricated the private sector The United States could now live beyond its means and continue waging the Cold War and its allies benefited from access to the booming US market and the strengthened US military umbrella As *Disruption* demonstrates a new symbiotic economic architecture powered the West but the Eastern European regimes increasingly became a burden to the Soviet Union They were drowning in debt and the Kremlin no longer had the resources to rescue them

Russian Foreign Policy and the End of the Cold War Mike Bowker, 1997 The cold war dominated international politics in the second half of the twentieth century Before Gorbachev became leader of the Soviet Union in 1985 few could ever have imagined a world without the East West divide Yet six years later the cold war was over The Berlin Wall was down Germany was reunited and Marxism Leninism had been abandoned throughout Europe How this happened is the main focus of the first half of this book The author looks in detail at both internal and external factors precipitating change in Russia Monocausal explanations are rejected Instead it is argued that the reason for change varied

over time and across issue areas. However, the book does emphasize the importance of Gorbachev and his reformist colleagues in initiating reform in the USSR and bringing the cold war to a peaceful end. The second half of the book looks at the post-soviet period when the initial euphoria over the end of communism gave way to growing unease both inside and outside Russia. Russian diplomacy in Yugoslavia and the war in Chechnya were just two of the most important prominent actions which led many Western commentators to accuse Moscow of adopting a more nationalist and aggressive foreign policy. However, the author argues that this shift in policy is easy to exaggerate. The brutal war in Chechnya was certainly a terrible warning of what could happen, but it remained untypical of policy during the Yeltsin period. A return to hostile relations with the West is not impossible, but it remains highly unlikely. For, in contrast to the cold war period, both sides now agree on the principles of a liberal international order, and this rather than the current weakness of Russia would seem to offer the best hope in the coming years for a co-operative, less antagonistic Russian policy towards its neighbours and the West.

Citizens from both East-bloc and Western countries, among them prominent scientists and physicians, formed networks to promote ideas and policies that would lessen this danger. Two of their organizations, the Pugwash movement and the International Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear War, won Nobel Peace Prizes. Still, many observers believe that their influence was negligible and that the Reagan administration deserves sole credit for ending the Cold War. The first book to explore the impact these activists had on the Soviet side of the Iron Curtain, *Unarmed Forces* demonstrates the importance of their efforts on behalf of arms control and disarmament. Matthew Evangelista examines the work of transnational peace movements throughout the Khrushchev, Brezhnev, and Gorbachev eras and into the first years of Boris Yeltsin's leadership. with Russian and Western activists and policymakers he investigates the sources of Soviet policy on nuclear testing strategic defense and conventional forces Evangelista concludes that transnational actors at times played a crucial role in influencing Soviet policy specifically in encouraging moderate as opposed to hard line responses for they supplied both information and ideas to that closed society Evangelista's findings challenge widely accepted views about the peaceful resolution of the Cold War By revealing the connection between a state's domestic structure and its susceptibility to the influence of transnational groups *Unarmed Forces* will also stimulate thinking about the broader issue of how government policy is shaped
