

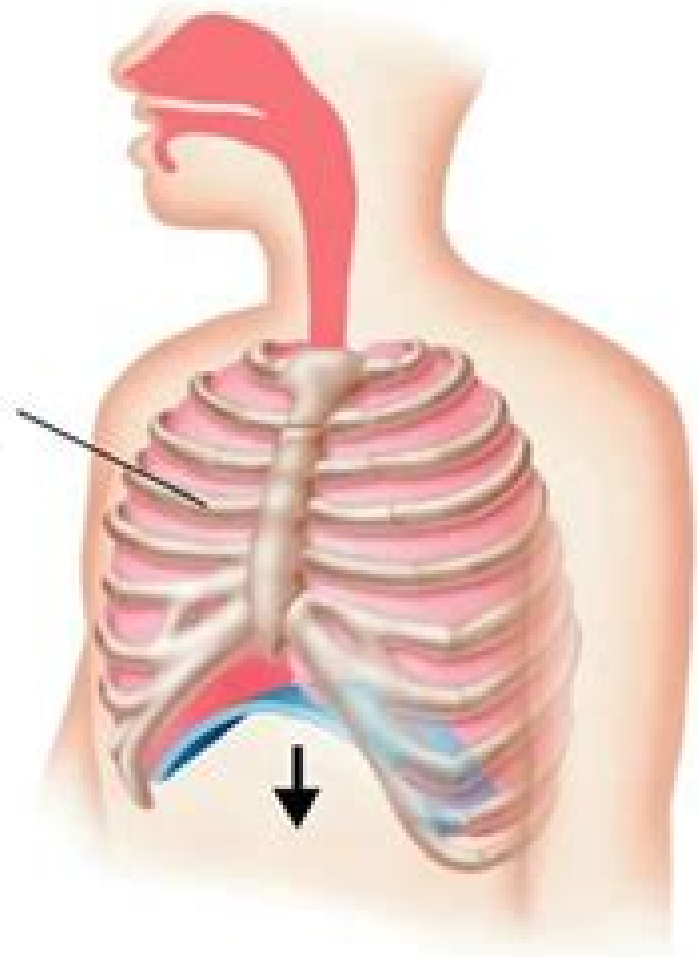
During inhalation, the diaphragm contracts and the rib cage rises up.
