TURNWALD, 1926 **Helsinki in Early Twentieth-Century Literature** Lieven Ameel, 2014-05-27 Helsinki in Early Twentieth Century Literature analyses experiences of the Finnish capital in prose fiction published in Finnish in the period 1890 1940 It examines the relationships that are formed between Helsinki and fictional characters focusing especially on the way in which urban public space is experienced Particular attention is given to the description of movement through urban space The primary material consists of a selection of more than sixty novels collections of short stories and individual short stories This study draws on two sets of theoretical frameworks on the one hand the expanding field of literary studies of the city and on the other hand concepts provided by humanistic and critical geography as well as by urban studies This study is the first monograph to examine Helsinki in literature written in Finnish It shows that rich descriptions of urban life have formed an integral part of Finnish literature from the late nineteenth century onward Around the turn of the twentieth century literary Helsinki was approached from a variety of generic and thematic perspectives which were in close dialogue with international contemporary traditions and age old images of the city and defined by events typical of Helsinki s own history Helsinki literature of the 1920s and 1930s further developed the defining traits that took form around the turn of the century adding a number of new thematic and stylistic nuances The city experience was increasingly aestheticized and internalized As the centre of the city became less prominent in literature the margins of the city and specific socially defined neighbourhoods gained in importance Many of the central characteristics of how Helsinki is experienced in the literature published during this period remain part of the ongoing discourse on literary Helsinki Helsinki as a city of leisure and light inviting dreamy wanderings the experience of a city divided along the fault lines of gender class and language the city as a disorientating and paralyzing cesspit of vice the city as an imago mundi symbolic of the body politic the city of everyday and often very mundane experiences and the city that invites a profound sense of attachment an environment onto which characters project their innermost sentiments *A History of Finnish Literature* Jaakko Ahokas, 1973 Part of a series that offers mainly linguistic and anthropological research and teaching learning material on a region of great cultural and strategic interest and importance in the post Soviet era **Papin tytär** Juhani Aho, 2021-07-29 Juhani Ahon romaani Papin tytär on syvällinen ja koukuttava tarina nuoren naisen identiteetistä ja sisäisestä kamppailusta Teos sijoittuu 1800-luvun Suomeen ja siihen yhdistyvä realistinen kirjallisuus ja moniulotteiset henkilöhahmot Aho käytti kauniisti

Juhani Aho 1861–1921 on yksi suomalaisen proosan merkkihenkilöistä ja hänen taustansa Papin perheessä vaikutti suuresti hänen kirjoittamiseensa. Aho oli aikansa modernismi ihminen, joka halusi murtaa perinteisiä narratiivisia rakenteita ja käyttää inhimillisiä tunteita realistisesti. Hänen monipuolinen tuotantonsa johon kuuluu novelleja, romaaneja ja esseitä peilaa aikakauden yhteiskunnallisia muutoksia ja ihmisen psykologisia syitä. Ahon omakohtaiset kokemukset, kuten opiskelu ja matkustaminen Euroopassa rikastuttivat hänen kirjoittamistaan ja näkemyksiä. grey area of the success story of rural lending libraries in the Nordic countries through the activities of people's libraries in one area of Central Finland. The study explores the influence of social, cultural, geographical and economic phenomena such as the spread of revivalist movements on the reading habits of the local population and reveals interesting reasons why the establishment of elementary schools and popular libraries and the growth of functional literacy did not automatically increase the informational capital of the common people of remote regions or lead to their social advancement. This study represents a methodological experiment in describing the life history of a people's library. The combination of collective biographical and transnational comparative methods with rarely utilized original sources in this study is innovative and has not been used before in Finnish historical research on functional literacy and popular libraries. The advantage of the comparison is that it reveals the attitudes to libraries that were characteristic of each of the cultures involved. For the people of the Finnish countryside in the late nineteenth century, libraries represented a way of acquiring new information that was still strange and unwelcome. The distribution of immaterial capital was extremely uneven with regard to age, gender and social rank. In the earlier Finnish research, it has not very often been analysed how the communal status of the peasant reader and his or her personal networks in the local community affected the quality of his or her reading habits. This book shows that the location of the library in its local community and, on the other hand, the status and position of its customers in their networks had a great significance on the use of the library and thus to the improvement of reading skills.

Arctic Hysteria and Other Strange Northern Emotions Elise Nykänen, 2024-11-08. *Arctic Hysteria and Other Strange Northern Emotions* Case Studies in Finnish Literature opens a new perspective on the thriving area of research on the imagined North by studying emotions in the light of case studies in Finnish literature. The volume addresses the cultural history of Arctic hysteria and maps other strange emotions depicted and evoked in literature of the Finnish North. The volume comprises seven case studies which range from the works of internationally renowned authors such as Rosa Liksom, Emmi Itäranta and Tove Jansson to the affectively controversial and provocative writings of Timo K.
