

The criteria for a Section 42 Safeguarding Enquiry under the Care Act 2014:

- The Care Act (Section 42) states that the Local Authority must initiate a safeguarding process for anyone who meets the following three criteria:
 - (a) has needs for care and support (whether or not the authority is meeting any of those needs),
 - (b) is experiencing, or is at risk of, abuse or neglect, and
 - (c) as a result of those needs is unable to protect himself or herself against the abuse or neglect or the risk of it.
- It is really important to consider part (c) carefully, and this is something you may want to discuss in a 'pre-referral consultation'.
