Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology

Definition: The study of the structure and function of the human body.

Branches:

- Anatomy:** The study of the structure of the body.
- Physiology:** The study of the function of the body.

Levels of Organization:

1. Chemical level
2. Cellular level
3. Tissue level
4. Organ level
5. Organ system level
6. Organism level

Homeostasis

Definition: The process by which the body maintains a stable internal environment.

Components:

- Stimulus:** A change in the environment that triggers a response.
- Receptor:** A sensor that detects the stimulus.
- Control Center:** The brain or other part of the body that processes the information and sends out a response.
- Effector:** A muscle or gland that carries out the response.

Cell Structure

Cell: The basic unit of life.

Parts of a Cell:

- Cell Membrane:** The outer boundary of the cell.
- Nucleus:** The control center of the cell.
- Mitochondria:** The powerhouses of the cell.
- Ribosomes:** The sites of protein synthesis.
- Endoplasmic Reticulum:** The network of membranes inside the cell.

Integumentary System

Definition: The system of the body that covers and protects the internal organs.

Components:

- Skin:** The outer layer of the body.
- Hair:** The hair on the body.
- Nails:** The nails on the fingers and toes.

Muscular System

Definition: The system of the body that allows movement.

Components:

- Muscles:** The muscles of the body.
- Connective Tissue:** The tissue that connects muscles to bones.

Skeletal System

Definition: The system of the body that provides support and protection.

Components:

- Bones:** The bones of the body.
- Joints:** The places where bones meet.

Cardiovascular System

Definition: The system of the body that transports blood.

Components:

- Heart:** The pump of the body.
- Blood Vessels:** The vessels that carry blood.

Respiratory System

Definition: The system of the body that takes in oxygen and gets rid of carbon dioxide.

Components:

- Lungs:** The organs of the body that take in oxygen.
- Trachea:** The windpipe.

Digestive System

Definition: The system of the body that breaks down food into nutrients.

Components:

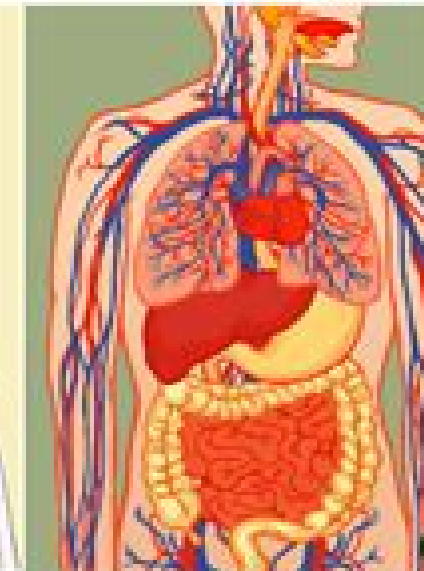
- Mouth:** The place where food enters the body.
- Stomach:** The organ of the body that breaks down food.
- Small Intestine:** The long tube of the body that absorbs nutrients.
- Large Intestine:** The shorter tube of the body that absorbs water.

Excretory System

Definition: The system of the body that gets rid of waste.

Components:

- Kidneys:** The organs of the body that filter blood.
- Ureters:** The tubes that carry urine from the kidneys to the bladder.
- Bladder:** The organ of the body that stores urine.



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Endocrine System

Definition: The system of the body that controls the body's functions.

Components:

- Pituitary Gland:** The master gland of the body.
- Thyroid Gland:** The gland in the neck.
- Adrenal Gland:** The gland on top of the kidney.

Reproductive System

Definition: The system of the body that produces offspring.

Components:

- Ovaries:** The glands in the female body that produce eggs.
- Uterus:** The organ of the female body where the fetus develops.
- Vagina:** The canal of the female body that leads from the uterus to the outside.

Immune System

Definition: The system of the body that defends against disease.

Components:

- White Blood Cells:** The cells of the body that fight infection.
- Antibodies:** The proteins of the body that destroy pathogens.

Nervous System

Definition: The system of the body that controls the body's functions.

Components:

- Brain:** The organ of the body that controls the body's functions.
- Spinal Cord:** The long tube of the body that carries messages from the brain to the rest of the body.
- Nerves:** The fibers of the body that carry messages.

Urinary System

Definition: The system of the body that gets rid of waste.

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
