Harvard Yale the University of Wisconsin Madison Johns Hopkins and Amherst College Several others served on the governing boards of the United States Military Academy at West Point and the United States Naval Academy at Annapolis Every reader of Patriots Twice has benefited from the post Civil War reconciliation when former combatants put down their swords picked up their plowshares and accepted the invaluable contributions of these and thousands of other former Confederates The men who carried the bayonets found common cause and moved on together This is an important concept everyone should no must embrace to keep America united strong and free
