The Nile flows through the sand.

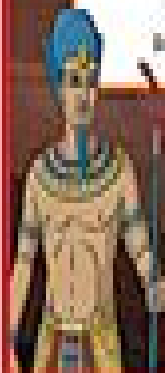
With golden treasures, kings once reigned,
