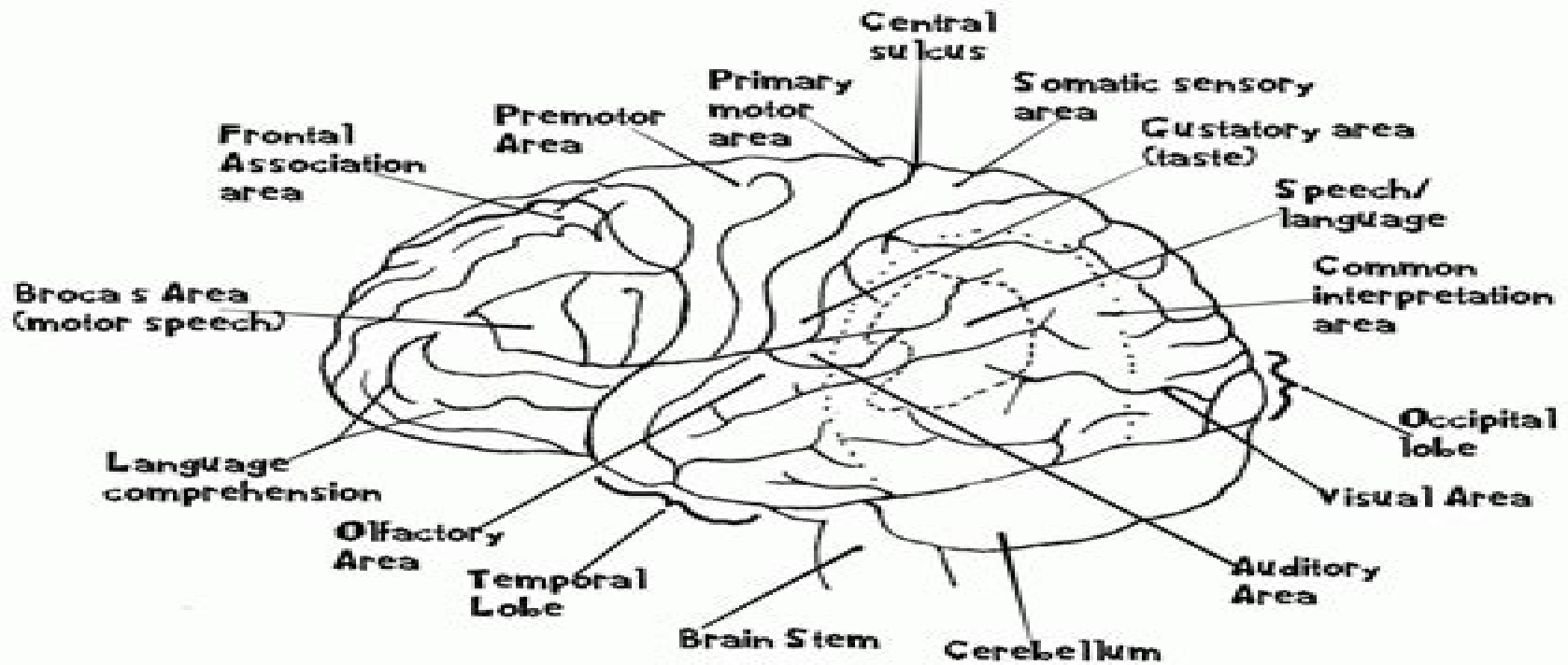


THE BRAIN
