#### Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its parts.

### CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



#### Organization of human body

The human body is organized into a hierarchy of structural levels.

1. **Chemical level** - study of the structure and function of chemical substances.

2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.

3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.

4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.

5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of systems.

6. **Whole body level** - study of the structure and function of the whole body.



The **axoplasm** is the cytoplasm of the neuron. It contains organelles such as mitochondria, Golgi apparatus, and endoplasmic reticulum.

#### Neurons

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

1. **Motor neurons** - carry out responses.- 2. **Sensory neurons** - carry out sensations.
- 3. **Interneurons** - carry out integration.

Neurons are specialized cells that transmit information.

### ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different tissues that perform a specific function.

1. **Heart** - pumps blood throughout the body.- 2. **Lungs** - exchange gases between the body and the environment.
- 3. **Stomach** - digests food.
- 4. **Intestines** - absorb nutrients from food.
- 5. **Kidneys** - filter waste from the blood.
- 6. **Bladder** - stores urine.
- 7. **Uterus** - carries and nurtures the developing fetus.
- 8. **Vagina** - canal for childbirth and menstruation.
- 9. **Penis** - organ of male reproduction.
- 10. **Testes** - produce sperm.
- 11. **Ovaries** - produce eggs.
- 12. **Pituitary** - secretes hormones.
- 13. **Thyroid** - produces thyroid hormone.
- 14. **Adrenal** - produces adrenaline.
- 15. **Pancreas** - produces insulin.
- 16. **Gallbladder** - stores bile.
- 17. **Spleen** - filters blood.
- 18. **Liver** - produces bile.
- 19. **Salivary glands** - produce saliva.
- 20. **Parathyroid glands** - produce parathyroid hormone.
- 21. **Thymus** - produces thymosin.
- 22. **Pineal** - produces melatonin.
- 23. **Hypothalamus** - controls the autonomic nervous system.
- 24. **Hypophysis** - secretes hormones.
- 25. **Adipose tissue** - stores fat.
- 26. **Cartilage** - provides support and flexibility.
- 27. **Bone** - provides support and protection.
- 28. **Skull** - protects the brain.
- 29. **Rib cage** - protects the heart and lungs.
- 30. **Vertebrae** - support the body.
- 31. **Muscles** - move the body.
- 32. **Skin** - protects the body.
- 33. **Nails** - protect the fingers and toes.
- 34. **Hair** - protects the body.
- 35. **Teeth** - chew food.
- 36. **Salivary glands** - produce saliva.
- 37. **Esophagus** - carries food to the stomach.
- 38. **Stomach** - digests food.
