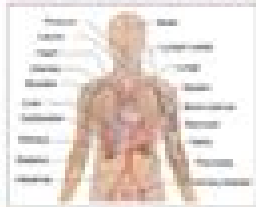
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HUMAN ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

Study of the human organism and its internal body



Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its internal organs.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its internal organs.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the human body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of systems.
- 6. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole organism.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.
- 2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.
- 3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between cells.
- 4. **Blood plasma** - fluid part of blood.
- 5. **Lymph** - fluid in lymphatic system.

The fluid inside the cell is called intracellular fluid, and the fluid outside the cell is called extracellular fluid.

ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues that perform a specific function.

Organs are composed of different types of tissues, including:

- 1. **Epithelial tissue** - covers the body and organs.
- 2. **Connective tissue** - supports and connects other tissues.
- 3. **Muscle tissue** - contracts to produce movement.
- 4. **Nervous tissue** - transmits electrical signals.

Organ systems

Organ systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

Organ systems are composed of different types of organs, including:

- 1. **Cardiovascular system** - pumps blood throughout the body.
- 2. **Respiratory system** - takes in oxygen and removes carbon dioxide.
- 3. **Digestive system** - breaks down food into nutrients.
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ORGANISMS

Organisms are living entities that can survive and reproduce on their own.

Organisms are composed of different types of organisms, including:

- 1. **Prokaryotes** - simple organisms without a nucleus.
- 2. **Eukaryotes** - complex organisms with a nucleus.
- 3. **Plants** - organisms that produce their own food.
- 4. **Animals** - organisms that consume other organisms for food.



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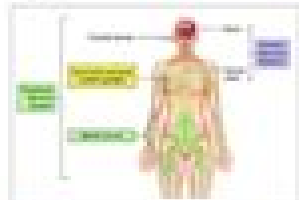
NERVOUS SYSTEM

Neurons

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

Neurons are composed of different parts, including:

- 1. **Cell body** - contains the nucleus and other organelles.
- 2. **Dendrites** - receive signals from other neurons.
- 3. **Axon** - carries signals away from the cell body.
- 4. **Myelin sheath** - insulates the axon.
- 5. **Synapse** - the point where neurons communicate.
