Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its parts.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its parts.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the cellular, tissue, organ, and system levels.

- 1. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 2. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 3. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 4. **System level** - study of the structure and function of systems.
- 5. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole organism.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Organization of cellular levels

Cells are organized into tissues, organs, and systems.

1. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.

The **epithelium** is the outermost layer of cells that covers the body. It is composed of cells that are closely packed together and form a barrier between the body and the environment.

Epithelium

Epithelium is the tissue that covers the body. It is composed of cells that are closely packed together and form a barrier between the body and the environment.

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ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues that work together to perform a specific function.

1. **Heart** - pumps blood throughout the body.

2. **Lungs** - exchange oxygen and carbon dioxide.

3. **Stomach** - digests food.

4. **Intestines** - absorb nutrients from food.

5. **Kidneys** - filter waste from the blood.

6. **Bladder** - stores urine.

7. **Uterus** - carries and nurtures the developing fetus.

8. **Vagina** - canal for childbirth.

9. **Penis** - male organ for sexual intercourse.

10. **Testes** - produce sperm.

11. **Prostate** - gland that produces fluid for sperm.

12. **Seminal vesicle** - gland that produces fluid for sperm.

13. **Utricle** - gland that produces fluid for sperm.

14. **Bladder** - stores urine.

15. **Urethra** - tube that carries urine out of the body.

16. **Penis** - male organ for sexual intercourse.

17. **Vagina** - canal for childbirth.

18. **Cervix** - lower part of the uterus.

19. **Vulva** - external female genitalia.

20. **Clitoris** - small, sensitive organ.

21. **Labia** - lips of the vulva.

22. **Perineum** - area between the anus and the vulva.

23. **Anus** - opening of the digestive tract.

24. **Rectum** - final part of the digestive tract.

25. **Sigmoid colon** - part of the large intestine.

26. **Cecum** - large pouch at the beginning of the large intestine.

27. **Ascending colon** - part of the large intestine.

28. **Transverse colon** - part of the large intestine.

29. **Descending colon** - part of the large intestine.

30. **Sigmoid colon** - part of the large intestine.

31. **Rectum** - final part of the digestive tract.

32. **Anus** - opening of the digestive tract.

33. **Utricle** - gland that produces fluid for sperm.

SYSTEMS

Systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

1. **Cardiovascular system** - pumps blood throughout the body.

2. **Respiratory system** - exchanges oxygen and carbon dioxide.

3. **Digestive system** - breaks down food into nutrients.

4. **Excretory system** - removes waste from the body.

5. **Reproductive system** - produces offspring.

6. **Immune system** - defends the body against disease.

7. **Nervous system** - controls the body's actions.

8. **Endocrine system** - produces hormones.

9. **Musculoskeletal system** - moves the body.

10. **Skin system** - protects the body from the environment.

11. **Thermoregulatory system** - maintains body temperature.

12. **Osmoregulatory system** - maintains body fluid balance.

13. **Acid-base balance system** - maintains blood pH.

14. **Electrolyte balance system** - maintains electrolyte levels.

15. **Glucose balance system** - maintains blood sugar levels.

16. **Calcium balance system** - maintains bone density.

17. **Vitamin balance system** - maintains vitamin levels.

18. **Mineral balance system** - maintains mineral levels.

19. **Water balance system** - maintains body fluid volume.
