Anatomy and Physiology Cardiovascular System

A closed system of the heart and blood vessels

- The heart pumps blood
- Blood vessels allow blood to circulate to all parts of the body

Functions of the cardiovascular system

Transport oxygen, nutrients, cell wastes, hormones to and from cells

Anatomy of the Heart

- Size of a human fist, weighing less than a pound
- Located in the thoracic cavity, between the lungs in the inferior mediastinum

Orientation

- Apex is directed toward left hip and rests on the diaphragm
- Base points toward right shoulder



Coverings of the heart

- Pericardium—a double-walled sac
 - Fibrous pericardium is loose and superficial

- Serous membrane is deep to the fibrous pericardium and composed of two layers
 - Parietal pericardium: outside layer that lines the inner surface of the fibrous pericardium
 - Visceral pericardium: next to heart; also known as the epicardium
- Serous fluid fills the space between the layers of pericardium, called the pericardial cavity



Walls of the Heart

- Epicardium
 - Outside layer; the visceral pericardium
- Mwocardium
 - Middle laver
 - Mostly cardiac muscle
- Endocardium
 - Inner layer known as endothelium

Four Chambers of the Heart

- Atria (right and left)
 - Receiving chambers
 - Assist with filling the ventricles
 - Blood enters under low pressure
- Ventricles (right and left)
 - Discharging chambers
 - Thick-walled pumps of the heart
 - During contraction, blood is propelled into circulation
