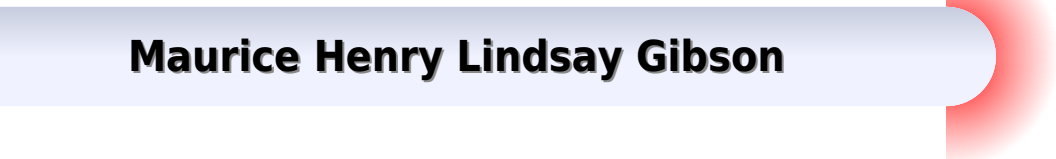
- **Homeostasis:** maintain internal environment

- **Respond to stimuli:** responding to environment
- **Reproduction:** sexual and asexual
- **Universal genetic code:** living things are based on DNA
 - Genetic code is basically the same for all organisms
