Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its internal organs.

Structural basis

The study of the structure of the human body and its internal organs.

- 1. **Cell** - the basic unit of life
- 2. **Organ** - a group of cells that work together to perform a specific function
- 3. **System** - a group of organs that work together to perform a specific function
- 4. **Organism** - the whole body

They are surrounded by a cell membrane.

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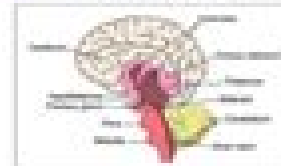

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

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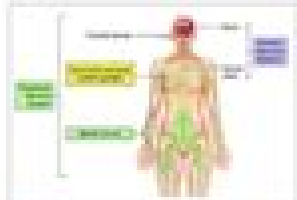
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
